Dan Diaz, EMS Coordinator, reported that Nikole DeLeon was to attend First Responder Class the upcoming Saturday.

A.J. Broes, Assistant Cemetery Sexton reported no activity.

Barry Gooding, Trustee, reported that the February Planning Committee meetings was canceled but that a meeting is scheduled to be held on March 27, 2018.

OLD BUSINESS

Gooding moved to pay the sexton an hourly rate of \$12.00 per hour for hall maintenance and miscellaneous jobs that may arise. Reimink seconded. Motion carried.

Aerial Testing in 2018, and 2018 5-Year Aerial Testing.
