A Note from Rick: Markets were steady this week at TLA. Just very little change in any livestock compared to a week ago. The one thing that did change a little was the hay market. We had more hay to offer and prices were a bit stronger. The hay market has been rather quiet throughout the summer, which is normal. Tuesday, however, was definitely more active. The better hay brought from \$200-\$230, with 1st cutting and grassy hay bringing from \$170-\$200. It will be interesting to see where our local hay market ends up this year. We have had a very good growing season with adequate rainfall to grow the hay, but also adequate weather to get the hay put up. This is not the case out west, where alot of hay is made and shipped into the Midwest. It was very dry and in several areas hay and pastures were very limited. Hay prices are much higher out there and how that will affect the Midwestern hay prices is yet to be seen. We had a ton of birds at our Alternative Animal Sale this weekend and were selling past 2am. Other than a crazy goat that busted through a gate and out on the town, things went very smoothly. Thank you to all of our employees that worked so hard to get all of the animals consigned, sold and distributed to the right buyers. They really amaze me with the system that they keep perfecting. Over 6,000 animals were sold and we had a great time doing it. That just shows how great our employees are! Enjoy the Fall weather and we'll see ya at TLA!
