Cancun Café & Mexican Grill opened recently in the former Munchies Restaurant location at 1559 Sycamore Road in Yorkville (331/207-8143).

The interior of the restaurant has undergone a complete transformation in décor and the addition of much greater seating. Owners Eva Gonzalez & Peter Antunes bring over 30 years of combined experience in the restaurant business to their new venture. Most recently, Eva spent the past six years at Yorkville's Lakeview Grille and Peter served as chef of La Quebrada restaurant in Aurora.

They specialize in fresh, homemade from scratch menu items for Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner.

A large Breakfast list of both Mexican and American choices includes Huevos a la Mexicana, Rancheros, Con Chorizo, Machacado, San Luis, Con Salchicha, and Con Chorizo Y Papas, Chilaquiles Rojos o Verdes and House Desayuno. All Mexican Breakfasts include rice, beans and an order of tortillas. American selections include Pancake Flight, 2x2x2 (Eggs, pancakes, bacon or sausage), Skillets (Mexican & Denver), Omelets (Plain, Denver, Spinach, Mushroom, or Mexican) and Oatmeal. All American breakfasts include hash brown potatoes.

Choose Soup with chicken, fish, shrimp or a combination of seafood. A wide variety of Appetizers are available: Fried Smelts, Calamari, Guacamole, Queso Fundido Cheese Dip plain or with Chorizo, French Fries, Nachos, Chicken Wings, Oysters, Shrimp, Tostados with Fish or Shrimp Cocktail, Fish or Shrimp Ceviche, Shrimp or Shrimp & Octopus Cocktail or Veulve La Vida.

House Specialties include Steak (Cecina Estilo Guerrero, Carne Asada, Estilo Mi Rancho, India Con Hongos, Molinera, A La Tampiquena, Oaxaquena, Capestre or India), Milanese or Costillas de Res, Lomo En Chile de Arbol, Chiles Rellenos and Cancun Burger. The menu also lists twelve Chicken dishes and sixteen Seafood dishes. Three Parilladas (family style dishes serving 2 or 3 persons) feature combinations of meat and seafood, all served with rice and beans.

On the simpler side, Mexican Favorites Tacos, Tortas, Burritos, Gorditas, Quesadillas and Tostados come with a selection of various ingredients. Other items are Sopas Huarraches with or without meat, Enchiladas Rojas or Suizas, Flautas, and Fajitas with steak, chicken, shrimp or a combination of all three, served with guacamole, salad, rice & beans.

A family friendly restaurant, there is a kids menu with Cheeseburgers, Quesadillas or Grilled Cheese Sandwiches and a list of Sides to add to any meal. Prices are moderate and competitive.
