### SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION DUE DATE: October 10, 2016

The Board of Directors of the Volusia County Fair Association will award a \$1000 college scholarship to qualifying graduating high school seniors who best exemplify their support of the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show. Up to a total of twelve (12) \$1000 scholarships may be awarded to students that meet exceptional qualifications. These twelve (12) scholarship are inclusive and includes the Cultural Arts Scholarship, the George Wilkins Scholarship, the Elvin B. Daugharty Scholarship the Volusia Stock Show Syndicate and the Volusia County Fair Scholarships. The applicants personal initiative in extra - curricular activities, and their own personal attributes that will ensure their success in the pursuit of higher education. A scholarship is to encourage young people to pursue a college education. Applicants must be or have been participants in the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show to qualify. Applications must be delivered to the Fair office on or before the due date. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- 1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior from an accredited high school in Volusia County and be a resident of Volusia County.
- 2. Each applicant must submit documentation showing they passed the FCAT exam and official document for PSAT, SAT, or ACT test requirements for high school graduation and include an official SAT and ACT test score report.
- 3. Each applicant must hold a 3.0 high school grade point average (based on a 4.0 system).
- 4. The applicant must be a member of FFA, 4-H or may be an Independent exhibitor at the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
- 5. The applicant must have participated as an exhibitor at the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show the past two (2) years.
- 6. The applicant must apply the scholarship funds for tuition or fees at a two or four year college and carry at least 12 credit hours. The funds will be assigned and administered by the applicant's college or university. Upon receipt, by the Fair office from the college or university, the funds will be mailed to the respective school. Should the chosen applicant drop out of school for any reason or not carry 12 credit hours, any unused portion of the scholarship funds will be returned to the Volusia County Fair Association.
- 7. The scholarship deadline for the use of funds will be March 31st following high school graduation; an exception will be made if the applicant will be serving as an FFA State Officer. Upon proof of the applicant's appointment as an FFA State Officer, the applicant will have two (2) calendar years after high school graduation to apply for the scholarship funds.
- 8. Upon receipt of confirmation of acceptance to your college or university, the funds will be sent by the Fair office to your account.
- 9. The award will be presented at an official activity of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
- 10. The Committee will use the following criteria for awarding scholarships:
