Peggy toured the United States and Europe with Peter Maxwell's Ballroom Dance Theater for a year. Afterward, she returned to competing, becoming a two-time Triple Crown American Smooth Champion, as well as two-time Fred Astaire National Dance Champion and a four-time finalist at the USDC.
