"Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble. whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable-if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things." Philippians 4:8

Even at a time when our country, and much of our world is in turmoil we still have so much for which to be thankful. The Apostle Paul was in prison when inspired by the Holy Spirit he wrote about disciplining our minds to think on things that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, and

praiseworthy. It's so easy for us to let our minds drift toward things that are false, wrong, impure, shameful, etc...

Paul points out in Philippians chapter 4 the danger of an undisciplined mind preventing us from remaining firm in our commitment to Christ and resulting in strife between believers. We seem to have more of a tendency to dwell on things that are negative and critical. That kind of thinking can cause us to become aggravated at our circumstances and at others. If anyone had a right to be aggravated with his circumstances and other people it was Paul sitting in his prison cell. However, because

he disciplined his thinking toward counting his blessings, he could say in v.10, "I rejoiced greatly in the Lord..."; v.11, "I have learned to be content in whatever the circumstances...": v.13, "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength."

So this Thanksgiving, and every other day of the year discover the contentment that results from dwelling on the many blessings we have from God, and from the blessings we enjoy from family, friends, and brothers and sisters in Christ!

We have our regular activities on Wednesday and Sunday for the month of November.


