Arnold I. Reibling, 81, Elkton area farmer, died Sunday, Feb. 16, 2003, at Mayo Clinic Hospital in Phoenix, Ariz. He was born on June 13, 1922 at the home of his parents, the late Erwin and Lillian (Steinman) Reibling in Chandler Township. On Dec. 7, 1946, he was united in marriage to Goldie E.
