




What are Hospice-Veteran Partnerships?

What is Hospice?

Hospice is about comfort, compassion and support for persons and their families when a life-limiting illness no longer responds to cure-oriented treatment.

Hospice care focuses on providing comfort and relieving pain and symptom management. Hospice also deals with the emotional, social and spiritual impact of the illness and works to promote dignity and quality of life.

Starting Hospice Services

Patients enter hospice care at various stages of their illnesses, the sooner they begin this specialized care the greater the benefits for the patient and family members.

Under the direction of your physician, hospice care begins with an assessment by a registered nurse. The nurse will evaluate your needs and develop an individualized plan of care. This evaluation includes a physical assessment, medication review and education of all support services available to the patients and their families.

Care For The Caregiver
