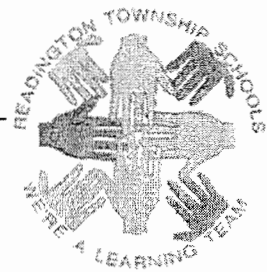


Readington Township Board of Education

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Readington Township Board of Education understands that there is a potential for Solberg Airport to expand the size of its main and crosswind runways, and

WHEREAS, the Readington Township Board of Education is aware that Three Bridges School would be on the flight path of larger aircraft approaching the main runway of such an expanded airport, and

WHEREAS, the Readington Township Board of Education is aware that Holland Brook School and Readington Middle School would be on the flight path of aircraft approaching the crosswind runway of such an expanded airport and such aircraft would be flying at an altitude of well under one thousand feet, and

WHEREAS, the Readington Township Board of Education believes that the noise from such aircraft would be a distraction to effective teaching and learning at Three Bridges School, Holland Brook School and Readington Middle School, and

WHEREAS, the Readington Township Board of Education believes that landing on an expanded crosswind runway would pose a perpetual and imminent safety threat to the children, staff and visitors at both Holland Brook School and Readington Middle School,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Readington Township Board of Education opposes the expansion of the Solberg Airport and encourages the Readington Township Committee to take appropriate action to prevent such expansion.
