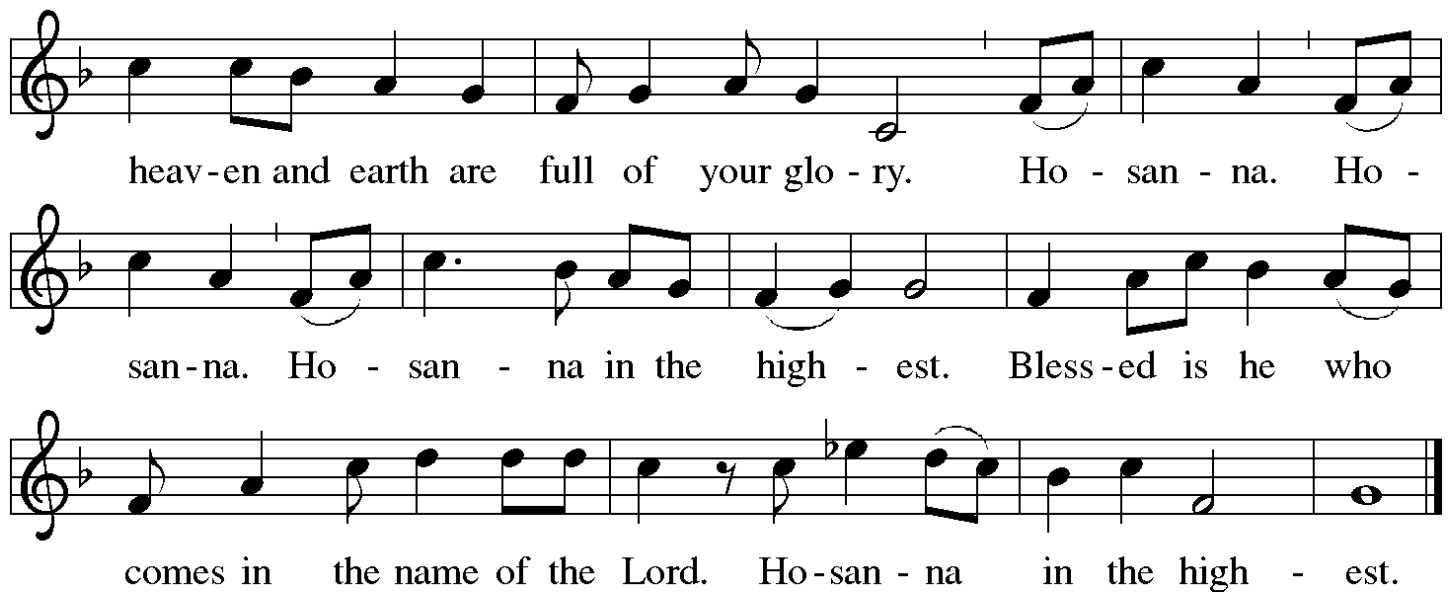
PREFACE

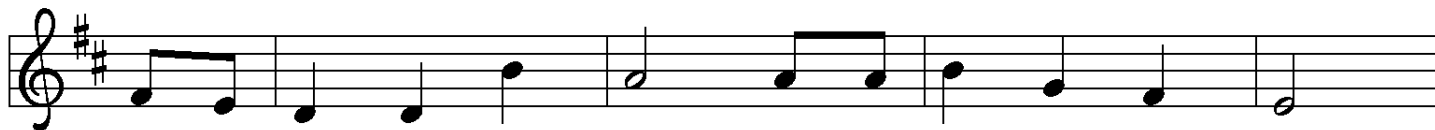
