- Preliminary Flood Maps were released for public viewing on June 30, 2016

  - Included notification on all tax bills of flood map changes
  - Public announcement posted on Craven County website
  - Public workshop will be held on November 2, 2016 at convention center. (3pm and 6 pm)

#### <u>Timeline</u>

- November 2, 2016 public workshop
- January 9,2017 (tentative) 90-day appeal period will start(Appeals should be sent to individual communities)
- March 2017 90-day appeal period will end
- March 2017 September 2017 State and their consultant will review appeals and respond to the communities.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2018 tentative community adoption and will become effective.
