Update

- Preliminary Flood Maps were released for public viewing on June 30, 2016
- Flood maps can be viewed at <http://fris.nc.gov/fris/>
- Public Outreach
 - Included notification on all tax bills of flood map changes
 - Public announcement posted on Craven County website
 - Public workshop will be held on November 2, 2016 at convention center. (3pm and 6 pm)

Timeline

- November 2, 2016 - public workshop
- January 9, 2017 (tentative) - 90-day appeal period will start (Appeals should be sent to individual communities)
- March 2017 – 90-day appeal period will end
- March 2017 – September 2017 – State and their consultant will review appeals and respond to the communities.
- 1st Quarter 2018 – tentative community adoption and will become effective.

- Craven County- 331 added, 456 removed
- New Bern- 715 added, 1 removed
- Havelock- 13 added, 4 removed
- Trent Woods- 74 added, 29 removed
- Bridgeton- 53 added, 0 removed
- River Bend- 56 added, 0 removed
- Cove City, Dover and Vanceboro- No Changes
