

# **Future Simple**

#### e.g.

I will go.
I will not go.
Will you go?

# **Conditional Tenses**

## e.g.

If the animals can eat, they will be happy. If the animals do not have food to eat, they will be hungry. If they go out of the chicken house, they cannot eat their food.

# Some / Any

# e.g.

Are there any animals? Is there some rice? There are some animals. There is some rice. There aren't any apples. There isn't any rice.

# **Relative Pronouns**

# e.g.

This is a duck <u>that</u> likes people. Lee is the boy <u>who</u> gives food to the chickens.

# **Question Forms**

```
e.g.
Why...? Because...
Will...?
```

Why are the animals happy? They are happy because they have food to eat.

Will you be here tomorrow? Yes, I will.

# **Phonic Emphasis**

/ch/ e.g. The children chase the chickens from the kitchen.

/cl/ e.g. The clever teacher can clean the clock in the classroom.

# **Tag Questions**

# **Indirect Forms**

Do you know where Lee is? (NOT: Do you know where is Lee?)

I don't know where Lee is. (NOT: I don't know where is Lee.)

I'm = I am
won't = will not
There's = There is
That's = That is
Where's = Where is
I'll = I will
We'll = We will
There aren't = There are not
Thanks = Thank you

# **Expressions**

Good morning.
Good afternoon.
All day.
Oh, no!
I think so.
Come on!
See you tomorrow.
I see. (= I understand.)
Go on!
Me, too.
All the time
... at all.
Well then, ...
All right (Alright)


