6. Old Business

The Board of Fire Commissioners, District 4 and the Fire Company will be researching a policy and program for zero tolerance for drugs and alcohol. This will also include a process and training of certain personnel for identification of potential "under the influence" and a medical method for determining that a member was actually "under the influence" in the event of an incident.

The Board of Fire Commissioners, District 4 and the Fire Company will be researching a policy and program for medical physical program for all Fire Company members.

A letter from Weir & Partners received for agreement to provide legal services. This letter will contract the Board and Weir & Partners and specifies an hourly rate for services. This letter will be tabled to the next meeting so that the absent Board members can review.

The blue light permits were re-submitted with the Board of Fire Commissioners letter. To date we, nor the applicants have received a response from MVC.

Joseph Bertino – Vineland Auto Electric presented the Board with the information needed regarding the repair work that will be needed for 43-52's generator. During regular preventative maintenance work it was found that the generator bearing is failing and requires replacement. The generator has below 50% shaft wear. If the bearing and shaft were allowed to completely fail, it would cause catastrophic damage to the generator and the repairs could exceed \$22,000.00. If we perform the needed repair before catastrophic failure, the cost estimate is \$8,490.24. Joe went into great detail explaining the possible outcomes and the Board agreed that the repair would need to be done, and we authorized Joe to temporarily disable the generator on Engine 43-52 to prevent any further damage.

Mykola "Nick" Myronowskyj made a motion to have the repair done immediately. Thomas Bellone Sr. seconded the motion. The Chairman agreed and the vote is 3 Aye, and 2 absent. The motion is approved and a PO was issued to Vineland Auto Electric to perform the needed repairs.

The Chief of the department will be advised and will make arrangements to have Engine 43-52 taken to Vineland Auto Electric to have the generator assembly removed and sent to the factory for repairs.



7. New Business

Local Finance Board Determination and Resolution was received. This document was given to the Chairman to file in the KME folder.

Atlantic Switch & Generator annual maintenance contract signed and will be sent to the company. The next annual preventative maintenance will be scheduled in the fall.

New member application was received from Kristian Anderson. His application was reviewed and in addition to the application not being fully completed, it was determined that he lives much too far outside of the area. Per the FGVFC Bylaws, ARTICLE II, Membership, Section 2. Membership shall be open to those applicants that live within the 4th, 9th, and a portion of the 10th voting districts of Franklin Township, Gloucester County, NJ and to those non-resident applicants that live within three miles of the firehouse. Members who move outside the fire district will still be classified as a member of the fire company. The prospective member will be sent a letter from the Board of Fire Commissioners explaining why his application was rejected.

Thomas Bellone received a phone call from Foremost Productions. They attempted to deposit a check that was over 90 days old and this check was rejected by the bank. The old check number is 10910 in the amount of \$388.08. Thomas Bellone Sr. will reach out to Foremost Productions and have them submit a letter with supporting documentation. Once this documentation is received we will review and reprocess the invoice if applicable.
