Notes for ANNA MARIE STEINER:

Her death writeup was published in the January 21, 1911 issue of the Victoria (Texas) Advocate. It showed that she lost her parents, husband, and daughter during the yellow fever epidemic in 1867. Afterwards she removed from Spring Creek to Victoria with the surviving members of her family, and according to the Victoria Advocate "she endured every hardship administering to the wants of stricken relatives and friends during the dreadful epidemic and her death recalls many heroic deeds she performed. God never created a nobler woman, no person ever led a purer life, Victoria never had a better citizen and no death ever caused more sincere sorrow..."

Anna Marie Steiner finished her education in Germany and received a diploma from the Catholic School which she attended. She was also educated in music and sang the first Mass in the St. Mary's Catholic Church in Victoria, Texas, and was accompanied by a full band.

They owned a piano which had been brought from Europe, and all were taught to play and sing and formed a family chorus, the mother often accompanied them on the guitar. This was related by Alfreda "Babe" Gramann.

Anna Marie Steiner Gramann's home on South Main Street in Victoria, Texas, was moved board by board from the Coletto Creek area, after the death of her husband. It was later the home of Minnie and Ida Gramann.

Article written for the Victoria Advocate in 1930 stated "She had a wide reputation as a musician. "

Notes for HENRICH CARL GRAMANN:

Came into the port of Galveston, Texas on the ship Everhard that departed Bremen, Germany on September 27, 1845 and arrived in Galveston on December 18, 1845. The Captains name was Maake the ship had 282 passengers and 59 families on board. He was listed as a farmer with 1 wife.

Following information was prepared about 1930 and was given to the Victoria Advocate " Henry Gramann immigrated to Victoria in the late 1840's, and was a well-known stock farmer of this county. He took a pride in raising fine stock, especially horses, and was one of the first stockraisers in this section to improve his herds, which won the championship at a number of stock shows...Henry Carl Steiner and his wife and son-in-law died in Victoria in 1867 of the yellow fever, their deaths occurring only a few days apart... Mrs. Steiner on October 6, Steiner on October 16 and Mr. Gramann October 27."

Was a member of Company C, 6 Connecticut Infantry Unit, Rank-induction-Private, Rank-Discharge-Private, Allegiance-Union.

Following article in Victoria Advocate. Henry Gramann was another well known Victoria County horse breeder. He won the prize at the Gulf Coast Fair held in Victoria in 1858 for the best exhibition of fine horses. The prize, a silver loving cup, is still in the possession of his daughters, Misses Minnie and Ida Gramann. He also was the father of H.C. Gramann, retired Victoria grocer. Mr. Gramann came to Texas from Germany in the forties and died during the yellow fever epidemic in 1867.

In an article for the Victoria Advocate (Victoria, Texas) in 1930 the following was written "Henry Carl Gramann was reared in Victoria, and after attending Private schools taught here by Capt. William H. Allen, later of San Antonio, and the late Prof. William T. Eichholz, he took a commercial course at Soule's Business College in New Orleans. Mr. Gramann served his apprenticeship in the grocery business under Adolph Goldman, and in March, 1878, he started his present business, which is the oldest established grocery business in Victoria, as well as one of the leading institutions of its kind in this city. In the summer of 1883 he was a Petit juror. In 1883 he was a member of Fire Co. #1 in Victoria. He was married in Abilene, Texas, October 10, 1882, to Anna Hanauer, the daughter of Anton Hanauer, a native of Wittenheim, Alsace, France, and Mary Anna Sengele Hanauer-Wissing, a native of Sennheim, Alsace, France, deceased. Mr. and Mrs. Gramann have had seven children, of whom six survive (as of 1930): Henry Theodore, Anna Augusta and Alfreda Columbia Gramann of Victoria and Mrs. William Frobese, Jr., Carl Anthony Gramann and Mary Louise Gramann of Cuero.....Mr. Gramann also has four sisters: Mrs. John C. Beasley, Sr., of Beeville and Mrs. August Klein and Misses Minnie and Ida Gramann of Victoria. "

Was a member of Victoria Hook & Ladder Company #2 in 1891. In 1908 was a trustee in the Knights of Columbus Victoria (Texas) Council #1329 and was one of the original 32 members when it was granted its charter on May 3, 1908 (certificate #4639).

The Gramann Grocery store was later a gift shop in Victoria, Texas.

Henry played the flute and was a tall handsome man with dark hair and a jolly disposition.

Gramann Grocery store was located on the east side of Main Street between Santa Rosa and Constitution Streets and later at 112 Santa Rosa Street.

Notes for MARY ANNA HANAUER:

Mary Anna was the daughter of Anton Hanauer an immigrant from Wittenheim, Alsace, France and Mary Anna Sengele and immigrant from Sennheim, Alsace, France. Mary was born 3 months after her father died. Her mother married Dr. Charles Wissing on March 31, 1856, they had no children. Mary Anna was often called by the Wissing name while growing up. At the age of 28 she married Henry Charles Gramann and they had 7 children, 6 of whom survived.

Mary Anna stressed cheerfulness when her children were growing up. She would often pin up some happy saying on the mirror, so each could see it when they went by or when they combed their hair.

She was an accomplished pianist. She was a member of St. Mary's Choir for years. Along with Reverend A. Gardet she greeted the first 5 Catholic sisters to arrive from Brownsville to Nazareth Academy in Victoria on December 21 1886 to open a convent and school and assisted in many school endeavors until her death. She is buried in the Catholic Cemetery in Victoria, Texas in Victoria County.

She was petite with blonde hair.

Mary and Henry established residence at 302 East Goodwin in Victoria, Texas. They owned Gramann Grocery in Victoria, Texas. The Gramann Grocery Store was established in 1878 by Henry Charles Gramann and was the oldest established grocery store in Victoria. It was originally located on the east side of Main Street between Santa Rosa and Constitution and later in a two-story brick building at 112 Santa Rosa Street. The store carried a complete stock of groceries, a select line of wood, willow, cut glass, and fine china. Henry Charles Gramann was assisted in his grocery by his two sons Henry Theodore Gramann and Carl Anthony Gramann.

The Gramann house was a place that was lived in from the attic to beneath the house where the boys built miniature cities or of wood and stones and they had play cattle, horses, and people, and they would use colored

rocks to distinguish between families. At Christmas the living room was closed for several days, then on Christmas Eve, Henry and Mary Anna would have their children line up before the door and at the tinkling of "Old Santa's Bell" the door would open and there would be a gorgeous tree set into a traditional little fence scene. At the base of the tree there were gifts for each child and gifts for friends. After opening gifts the family would rest and there were unplanned informal parties and Mary Anna would always prepare good things to eat for snacks when a group of young people dropped in.

Mary Anna was an accomplished pianist. Listening to and enjoying good music was a trait displayed by every member of the Gramann family. Henry Charles and their oldest son Henry Theodore played the flute, 3 daughters played the piano and the youngest son Carl and daughter played the violin. Music could be heard almost every night at their home. Every member of the family sang beautifully and all were members of St. Mary's choir for years.

Mary Anna and Henry's devotion to one another was instilled and reflected in their children. They made their home life ideal and a home that was open to friends at all times. They were just as in love on their 50th Wedding Anniversary as they had always been.

Notes for ALFREDA COLUMBIA GRAMANN:

Alfreda Columbia, called Babe because she was the youngest of her siblings. Was also called Babe or BuBa (long u, short a). Babe never married and devoted her life to her family, her church, and her community. Growing up in the Gramann house each had his or her work to do, Babe learned to cook, clean house, sew, tat, and crochet. After the chores were done there were plenty of children in the neighborhood to play with. As a young girl, Babe and her group of friend's roller-skated, doing both trick and dancing on skates. She was a popular young woman, very active in Victoria society. She and her group of friends often had horseback riding dates, parties, go picnicking, and boat riding down the river. As she grew older there were sophisticated formal dances and informal parties. She was educated at Nazareth Academy and by Prof. H.D. Lawrence. She enjoyed playing both bridge and canasta, and watching polo and baseball.

Babe had a great love for music and began playing the violin when the family needed a second violin part to play the "Bohemian Girl". Each Gramann family member played an instrument. Babe had a great interest in the Victoria Music Club holding every office except president, which she refused to hold. She directed the choir at St. Mary's Church for several years and part in various choral groups and sang in the Music Club chorus. She was one of the original 56 members of the Court St. Ann No. 329 of the Catholic Daughters of America that was organized May 19, 1919. She was president of the Sodality of Children of Mary for 25 years, member of St. Mary's Altar Society, an auxiliary member of the Legion of Mary, active in the Nazareth Academy PTA, and life member of St. Joseph's Mother's Club. She was active in the Junior Bronte Club, where young women studied fine arts, literature, and music at meetings, until it ceased activities, and she was an honorary member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy. She was the oldest graduate of Nazareth Academy at the time of her death.

In 1934, when Babe's oldest sister Sophie died, her son Bill came to live with Babe. Having him with her brought many happy moments, she said. Her nieces and nephews looked forward to a visit to the Gramann home, as Babe would have a wonderful meal of baked roast, asparagus tips and rice, and a crystal glass filled with fresh milk, waiting for them. During World War II she helped others, by renting out rooms in her home to couples and army wives. She became very active in Red Cross work and helped at the USO whenever possible. Babe was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church but Our Lady of Lourdes Church was also very special to her.

She was a tall dark headed woman who always had a smile and a kind word for everyone.
