Call to order: The General meeting of the Arleta School PTA was called to order at 6:05 pm at Arleta School on Tuesday, November 12, 2019, by Arleta PTA Co-President Melissa Sircy.

Principal update: John Horn will be here through Friday of this week. He can't answer whether he will stay longer if asked. He has been working on supervision before and after school and trying to make teachers and students feel safe.

Approval of minutes: We approved the minutes of October 8, 2019 without changes.

Budget Report: Chelsea provided an updated budget. We have a good, healthy start to the Dolphin Drive, and it looks like we've met our goals. November saw money come in, too, but the budget is for October.
