SUMMER VILLAGE OF SILVER SANDS

Being a By-Law of the Summer Village of Silver Sands to control and regulate the disposal of sewage and waste water within certain areas and on certain properties within the Summer Village.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Sands may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health, welfare and the protection of people and property; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Sands is concerned that outdoor privies and the disposal of sewage and waste water in certain areas and on certain properties within the Summer Village may pose a threat to the safety, health and welfare of the residents of the Summer Village of Silver Sands and the properties within the Summer Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Sands, for the safety, health, welfare and protection of the residents of the Summer Village and the property within the Summer Village, wishes to pass a by-law to regulate the disposal of sewage and waste water in certain areas and on certain properties within the Summer Village on the terms set out in this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Summer Village of Silver Sands, in Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "Approved System" shall mean a private sewage disposal system or private sewage disposal and treatment system which is installed and maintained in compliance with the provisions of the Safety Codes Act, S.A. 1999 C. S-0.5 and the regulations thereunder;
 - (b) "Owner shall mean the person or persons registered as the owner or owners of a parcel of land within the Summer Village of Silver Sands;
- By September 30, 2003 an Approved System shall be installed and maintained on all those properties which are located within the corporate limits of the Summer Village of Silver Sands, and which are being used for residential purposes.
- 3. Notwithstanding Section 2 of this by-law, by September 30, 2003 an Approved System shall be installed and maintained on all those properties within the Summer Village which have a Water System on them.
- 4. After September 30, 2003 no owner of a parcel of land which is within one of the areas described in Section 2 of this by-law or which is a property described in Section 3 of this by-law shall have, permit or allow an outdoor privy or any other system for the disposal of sewage or waste water on the parcel of land which results in the disposal of sewage and waste water into the ground.
- 5. A By-Law Enforcement Officer or any designated officer of the Summer Village of Silver Sands shall, subject to compliance with the requirements of Sections 542 and 543 of the Municipal Government Act (Alberta) 1999 C.M-26.1, be entitled to enter any lands within the Summer Village for the purpose of carrying out an inspection to determine compliance with this by-law.

- 6. Any Owner of a parcel of land which contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction:
 - (a) for the first offence, to a fine of \$500.00
 - (b) for the second offence, to a fine of \$1,000.00 and
 - (c) for the third and each subsequent offence, to a fine of \$2,500.00 and

in addition to those fines, for each offence the owner of the parcel of land is additionally liable to a fine of \$100.00 per day for each day after September 30, 2003 that the property remains in contravention of this by-law.

THIS BY-LAW SHALL COME INTO FORCE AND EFFECT ON THE DATE OF ITS FINAL READING.
