The winner of the contest will receive Rodeo Tickets, a restaurant gift card and bragging rights.

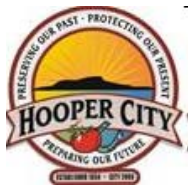


Bill Pay by Credit Card

From Our Sewer Department

In a storm event, the amount of demand on the sanitary sewer system increases significantly. This demonstrates that many homes are discharging ground water (sump pumps) into the sanitary sewer. This is illegal and is causing premature failure of pumps and vacuum valves and increased power usage creating unanticipated costs to our sewer system.

It has also been noted that some homes have modified the air intake (the candy cane). This intake must be a minimum of 18" from finished grade otherwise debris, small animals or other objects could be sucked into the service pipe and could create a blockage or cause failure of the vacuum pit.

It is essential to have un-obstructed access to vacuum valve pit lids. Please do not landscape or park vehicles or trailers over them. Please take corrective action if you have these issues. Contact the city office if you have questions.

4300 West Project

Hooper City and Clinton City have partnered to complete the half mile gap between Hooper's 4300 West and Clinton's 3000 West. This will give citizens more options in their commute.
