- No animal, including household pets, shall be maintained by any co-owner unless specifically approved in writing by the association
- Any pet permitted to kept in the condominium shall have such care and restraint as not to be obnoxious on account of noise, odor or unsanitary conditions
- All rules stated in section 11 apply

Additional rules adopted by association

Cats

- Indoor Cats will be allowed within the association
- A maximum of two cats per unit
- Each cat shall remain inside the unit unless it is transported in a pet friendly cage
- Each unit with a cat shall keep their unit in a sanitary condition, so not to attract any unwanted pests.

Restrictions
