

Quality of Finishing/Acceptable Practises

All work to be displayed must be ready to hang as follows:

1. Paint must be dry.
2. Wire must be attached securely across back of artwork as shown. Sawtooth style or other types of hangers are not accepted.



3. Wire must be attached to either of the following and be placed 1/3 of the way from the top. Wire should be a little loose but must not hang above the top of the frame/canvas:



D-Rings (examples shown below)



(attach to sides of frame)



Closed Hooks



(attach to inside of frame)



4. Artwork on canvas may be unframed if it is back wrapped canvas (no staples visible along the sides) with no frayed edges visible. The sides should be finished by the image continuing over the edge, or painted a solid colour.
5. Artwork on paper must be framed. Frames should be in good condition with no chips or nicks.
6. All artwork must be securely attached to the frame.
7. To assist in hanging art work so that it remains straight, adding “no slip stoppers” to the bottom corners will help. (These are also used for cabinet doors so they close quietly and can be bought in most hardware stores as well as some Dollar stores.)
