Dear Parish Council

Following the decision by SNC to uphold the decision to list Jubilee Field as an Asset of Community Value, and taking the results of the Parish Plan into account, Friends of Jubilee Field ask that the Parish Council now seriously consider all Jubilee Field issues.

Alongside the points already noted, PC has received information from SNC regarding the difficulties with future Planning Permission for housing on Jubilee Field, so it is time to allow the Jubilee Field to grow as a community space. Plans have been blocked for 18 months so let us move forward. It has been deemed a site that improves social well being within the ACV, so now let it fulfil its potential.

FOJF believe it is now time to bring peace to this unhappy Parish by addressing the points noted below. The points need immediate attention and should be a full agenda item, please. Let this be a first with the Parish Council actually discussing these matters with the groups concerned.

The areas which should be addressed urgently are:

1. Parish Council to give a full update on the status of the Jubilee Field Tesco Grant including evidence of communications with Groundworks and assurances that the funds will be

retained and spent on Jubilee Field - the area where the grant was allocated to.

2. Allow planning permission for a) nest swing and b) play equipment on Jubilee Field to go ahead. Funds for the nest swing are already in place, and Parish Council have previously agreed to apply for planning permission, so we see no reason why this cannot go ahead. The planning permission also needs to include proposals for the additional play equipment which the Jubilee Field Tesco Grant is to be spent on, but there is no reason why the nest swing cannot be installed first, followed by the rest of the equipment if this should prove to be the most sensible way forward.
3. We would add that as Councillor New stated, at the July Parish Council meeting, that it was possible to find land in Lower Boddington and install play equipment at no cost to the parish, then play equipment in Lower Boddington is no longer an issue which needs to be considered. This is a clear "quick win" for the Parish and we believe that there is another "quick win" with installing play equipment on Jubilee Field, again at no cost to the parish as funds have already been raised.
4. We need to understand why the JF funds raised are stated as £4,237.40 in minutes dated November 2nd, 2016,) which would not have included the funds raised at the bonfire) yet in the minutes dated December 7th, 2016 this figure is reduced to £2,200.07. We believe that the only way to resolve this issue is with a face to face meeting between the RFO and members of the former JFG.

5. To give agreement for further grants to be applied for.

We ask Parish Council to add these items to the agenda for the August PC meeting please and we would also welcome the opportunity to discuss all of the above points in a meeting with Parish Council.
