Description of PFOC Volunteer Positions

Club Picnic: The picnic is an annual fun event scheduled in March or April. A chairman is needed oversee the organization of the picnic. Volunteers are needed to help with planning games, selecting prizes, judging the various categories & organizing the potluck food & drinks.

Seminar: PFOC actively promotes educational seminars on various dog training topics. The seminar chairman would work with the Board in the selection of a speaker. The chairman would be in charge of making all arrangements for the speaker, selecting a site, arranging publicity & hospitality for the seminar.

CGC: PFOC sponsors AKC Canine Good Citizen (CGC) tests. People interested in organizing & administering the test are needed.

Training Line: Pick up messages 1 week per month from PFOC's training phone line. Mail training class packets and advise callers on specific dog problems.

Meeting Programs: Arrange for a speaker or a presentation at our 5 general meetings.

Stewarding: Assist the judge in the obedience or rally ring & perform any tasks the judge requests. A knowledge of ring procedure & rules governing judging is necessary.

Obedience/Rally Instructor: Teach PFOC training classes. First time instructors apprentice under an experienced instructor before becoming an instructor.

Training Apprentice: Assist an instructor in teaching classes in preparation for becoming an instructor.

Training Helper: Assist an instructor in teaching classes.

Ring Setup: Unload & load the trailer at PFOC classes and set up practice rings.

Newsletter: Help with the monthly club newsletter as editor, reporter or photographer.

Matches: This is a half-day fun match run by PFOC members. Help is needed to unload & load the equipment trailer and set up & tear down equipment. We also need help with hospitality, obedience or rally judging and stewarding duties. This is an opportunity to learn about ring procedure and stewarding from experienced exhibitors.

Obedience Trial: Help is needed to set up and tear down for PFOC's January obedience trials. You can also volunteer to help with hospitality or trophies. If you have training as a steward, you can volunteer for a stewarding assignment.



2019-2020 Phoenix Field & Obedience Club Awards Application Form

The purpose of PFOC's annual awards is to honor members who, with their dogs, have won obedience and other dog-related titles. The following policy is reviewed at least every 3 years. It shall be effective as of January 1, 2018.

I. Qualifications for an award:

A. The applicant must be a PFOC member in good standing.

- B. The applicant must be the owner of the dog or a member of the immediate family or household of the owner.
- C. The applicant must have trained and shown the dog in earning the title being applied for.
- D. An applicant must have earned an AKC Beginner Novice or more advanced obedience title or a Rally Novice title to receive the original plague.
- II. One free plaque will be awarded per dog. Plaques are wooden and display the PFOC logo. A metal plate engraved with the dog's registered name and breed will appear on the plaque.
- III. After the applicant has qualified for the original plaque, in accordance with I-A through D above, the applicant may apply for engraved metal plates recognizing individual titles. These will include title name and date earned. All non-AKC awards will have the awarding organization's initials appear before the title (example: NADAC, USDAA, ASCA). Metal plates may be purchased at a cost of \$7 each.
- IV. All applications for all title awards must be accompanied by a copy of the title-awarding organization's certificate or acknowledgement of the title. If you have not received the certificate yet, a list of the shows or tests in which the dog received credits for the title must be sent. If you are applying for awards for multiple dogs, please use one application per dog and include copies of all titles being applied for. Additional award applications are available in the PFOC newsletter and on our web site (pfoc.club).
