Emergency Home Repair Programs Available to Qualifying Mentor Residents

Low-to-moderate income Mentor homeowners in need of critical home repairs may qualify for assistance through programs offered by the City of Mentor.

These programs are designed to help homeowners in need make their homes safe, sanitary, and secure. Projects could include, but are not be limited to heating, roofing, electrical, or plumbing repairs as well as providing or enhancing ADA accessibility.

In order to qualify, the applicant must be the owner/occupant of a home in the City of Mentor, meet income requirements, and be either disabled or a veteran.

These programs are funded through the Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant Program which provides communities with resources to address a wide range of unique community development needs.



exceptions to this. I will try to lay this out in a simplistic fashion:


In a chapter 7 you will be able to discharge all of your debts without paying anything back. However, if you have any equity in anything (your home, your car, your bank account, your boat- anything) you must surrender it to the bankruptcy trustee (the person who looks out for the creditors) so that it can be sold (liquidated) to pay back the creditors to the largest extent possible. Equity is what determines which chapter of bankruptcy you can file under. Fair Market Value minus Amount Owed equals Your Equity in anything.

chapter 13 is a non-Α liquidating bankruptcy.

This means you get to keep everything, but you have to pay back a percentage of your equity. It is also used for people who are in foreclosure or behind on their mortgage and in fear of foreclosure. A chapter 13 requires a payback plan from between three to five years. The payment is monthly. The amount is determined, again, by the amount of equity you have accumulated in your life. This is referred to as your bankruptcy estate. Obviously, everyone wants to do a chapter 7 because it is no pay back. However, since 2005 it has become much harder to file chapter 7. In 2005, legislation was passed which tightened up the income restrictions on people with regard to the Chapter 7 bankruptcy. The intended result was that more people must file under Chapter 13 of the Bankruptcy code and pay back, at least, what the government thinks they can afford.

It is the bankruptcy attorney's job to advise you which is the best chapter to file under. It is also the attorney's job to make sure you keep your home, your car, and everything else you have accumulated throughout your life.

A good bankruptcy attorney will do those all of those things. He or She will also stop the creditors from harassing you, protect you from lawsuits, garnishments, put you back on your feet and give you a fresh start in life.

Safe Dog Handling for Seniors

Owning a pet can contribute to better health and a more active lifestyle. As more seniors become/ continue to be pet owners, the benefits of owning a pet dog may come with some unfortunate side effects.

University A recent Pennsylvania study found emergency room patients 65 and older with injuries from walking leashed dogs increased from 1,671 injuries in 2004 to nearly 4,400 in 2017. Nearly 80 percent of those patients were women, most commonly with hip fractures followed by injuries to the wrist or upper arm.

While some of these incidents can be attributed to the environment (slippery sidewalks etc.) many of the incidents were likely a result of a dog that was not trained to walk on leash. Leash skills are critical for any dog owner, but become increasingly important as the dog-owning population ages and more seniors are enjoying pet ownership.

Things to consider if you

are a senior or know a senior considering adding a dog to the household:

- Energy Level: Make sure that your physical condition and lifestyle can accommodate the dog's exercise needs
- Size of the Adult Dog: Large and giant breeds may be too physically demanding for a senior, particularly if the dogs have poor leash skills and manners (jumping.) Large dogs may also prove difficult to transport.
- Training: Can the dog be physically managed while participating in obedience training to improve manners?

We encourage seniors to do a compatibility assessment of a potential pet to assure that the dog can be safely handled at home and in public before committing to the new pet.







smell). As the reservoir of fungus grows to several billion spores in the colony, our noses detect the smell of these fungal gases.

dependent on three variables. Our individual immune systems, the type of spore and the volume of fungal gas, determines the impact on our bodies.

Additionally, the longer the exposure to these gases, the greater the likely hood we will develop a sensitivity. Much like other environmental allergens we are exposed to, the longer the exposure, the greater the chance our bodies will have an adverse reaction.

Some health effects include, headaches, shortness of breath, dizziness, lethargy, fever, and digestive problems. More severe reactions are hypersensitivity, and asthma symptoms. Although rare, certain Aspergillus species release aflatoxins that are carcinogenic.

There are many things in life we cannot control, but exposure to fungal gases is not one of them. With a little effort, we can reduce or eliminate this health hazard by using a disinfectant or removing the affected material. In some instances, it may be necessary to seek a professional opinion or get professional help.
