

Make 2

"O CHRISTMAS TREE"

- Read all instructions before starting.
- All seam allowances are 1/4".
- WOF = width of fabric

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - 2 1/2" x WOF strip

Sub-cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (B)

1 - 2 1/2" x 22" strip

Sub-cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (A)

1 - 2 1/2" x 22" strip

Sub-cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (A)

1 - 2 1/2" x WOF strip

Sub-cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (A)

1 - 1" x WOF strip

Sub-cut 2 - 1" x 4 1/2" rectangles (D)

1 - 4 1/2" x WOF strip

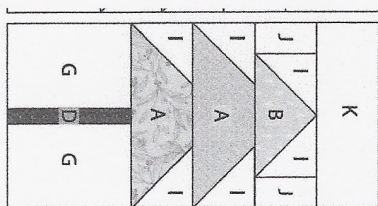
Sub-cut 4 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangles (G)

2 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

Sub-cut 12 2 1/2" squares (I)

Sub-cut 4 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles (J)

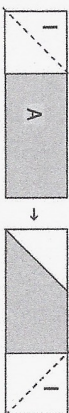
Sub-cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (K)



BLOCK PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

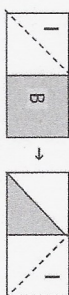
Step 1: Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on all I squares. Place an I square on the left side of an A rectangle, right sides together. Stitch on your marked guideline. Trim 1/4" away from your seam. Press I triangle out. Repeat on the right side of your A rectangle.

Make 4 "A" units. See picture on the front page for fabric placement.

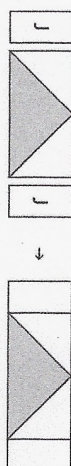


Step 2: Place an I square along one end of a B rectangle, right sides together, and stitch along previously marked guideline. Trim 1/4" away from your seam. Press I triangle out. Repeat on the right side of your B rectangle.

Make 2 "B" units. See picture on the front page for fabric placement.

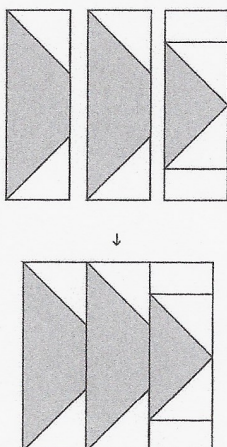


Step 3: Sew a J rectangle to both sides of your B unit. Press towards the J fabric. Make 5 units.

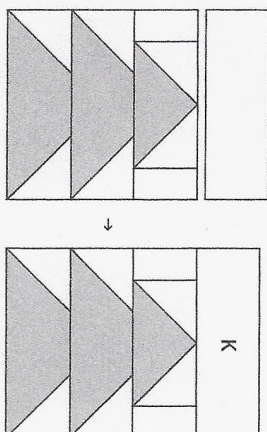


Step 4: Sew A and B units together to make your trees.

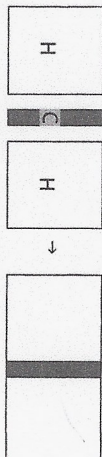
Make 5 trees, see picture on the front page for fabric placement.



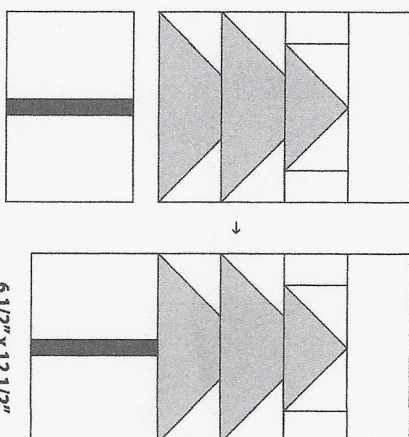
Step 5: Sew a K strip to the top of two of your trees. (The trees without the stars) Press towards the K. **Refer to picture for fabric placement on the trees. **



Step 7: Sew a C strip between two H rectangles. Press towards the H fabric. Make three.



Step 8: Sew a D trunk unit to the bottom of your two trees (without stars). Press towards the trunk unit.



6 1/2" x 12 1/2"
Make two.

Step 6: Sew a D strip between two G rectangles. Press towards the G fabric. Make two.
