This program will encourage driven dressage and education striving towards better dressage, as well as increased ADS membership and more events offering dressage to be ADS recognized.

□ Blue Medal: ADS Training Level Tests


- □ Bronze Medal: ADS Preliminary Tests
- □ Silver Medal: ADS Intermediate Level Tests and / or FEI 1' Tests

□ Gold Medal: ADS Advanced Level and / or FEI 2" or 3" Tests for equivalent = tests driven at FEI World Championships

Requirements:

For each level four tests of the required level – or higher (see note below 1 below) – with a score of below 48 penalty points – or above 70% - are required. Note: For all tests which do not have Presentation included – all ADT tests as well as others which are not POM (Presentation on the Move) the 70% equals 45 penalty points, so for those the score must be below 45 penalty points.

COUNTRY GIG, Pony road cart: 2 wheeled easy entry pony road cart. Fits 12.2 to 13 hh pony. Includes custom made washable water/dust resistant seat cover/protector, and full water resistant dust cover and matching shaft covers along with a very nice stand. The upholstery is made of dust resistant gray cord and the seat is wedge shape for comfort and correct seat and leg position. The seat is adjustable to balance the vehicle, a toe rail is included. Each side has a step to enter, the rein rail is of white metal as are the shaft tips. The shafts are wrapped with patent looking material. The hubs on the wheels are flush for obstacle driving and enhance the appearance of the 38 inch wheels. Shaft length is 57", width at cross bar is 33" and 22" at the most narrow part. The American Driving Society (ADS) has a great program that recognizes your time spent in the box. It is open to members of the ADS and is completely on the honor system. Simply record the time spent in the carriage (they do have a log that you can use to record time) and get recognized for driving 100, 250, 500, and 1000 hours! These hours roll from one year to the next so you don't have to do it all in a year.

In November, turn in your hours (for each milestone) and be recognized in the ADS's beautiful magazine, "The Whip," January edition, and receive a lapel pin with the hours displayed.

These hours are hours spent driving "recreationally" and time spent showing should not be counted (though, they aren't checking where the hours come from and sometimes ADS gives contradictory information).
