INTERIOR RESTORATION: When the Parish Finance Committee discussed about the interior restoration of the church, they also discussed about updating the sound system, lighting, washrooms and confessional and we needed to raise almost \$300,000.00. Later we discussed to finish the interior restoration first and then do the other work at a later date according to the financial position of the parish. Right now, our complete interior restoration cost is \$450,000.00 and we need to raise only \$140,000.00 (apart from our savings) and we have gotten up to \$35,454.00 and still need \$104,546.00. I hope this will give a clear picture of our project.
