MAINTAINING THE SPIRIT OF THE SEASON OF LENT: The

Spirit of the season of Lent should be maintained throughout the weeks of Lent. The obligation to observe penitential days of the Church is a very important part of our spiritual life. Individual circumstances must be taken into account, but in general, people should seek to do more rather than less, since fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimal response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion of life.



IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM LITURGICAL DOCUMENTS FROM THE RITE

OF PENANCE: "The season of Lent is most appropriate for celebrating the sacrament of penance. Already on Ash Wednesday the people of God has heard the solemn invitation 'Repent and believe in the Gospel.' It is therefore fitting to have a penitential celebration during Lent, so that all the faithful may have an opportunity to be reconciled with God ad their neighbor and so be able to celebrate the paschal mystery in the Easter Triduum with renewed hearts" (13).

■ 10th March 2018 CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING:

PROTECTING THE DIGNITY OF THE HUMAN PERSON
