In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

**WAIT LIST INFORMATION**

WCOTC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial’s closing date/time. A maximum of 10 entries per trial will be placed on the club’s wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **April 30, 2021 by 5:00pm (Eastern Daylight Time)**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on April 30, 2021 by 5:00pm. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund

**STAGING AREA, HANDLER’S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION**

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The Handler’s Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler’s Briefing the judge will explain if there’s an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler’s Briefing.

If entries allow enough space, a warm-up area will be available consisting of ONE container of Birch and may also consist of blanks containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

**Trial Site.** It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state “No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area.”

**Spectator Area.** **Due to COVID guidelines, no spectators are allowed in the search area.**

Crating space will not be available. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). **Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.**

Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY** The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog’s harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches).

Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

**REFUNDS** No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund. Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first

class of the day of the trial. RINGSIDE Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** At check-in you will receive your run number. Exhibitors **MUST** check-in EACH day they are entered

### **COVID-19 Precautions and Protocols**

1. Masks **MUST** be worn at ALL TIMES while on WCOTC property. Masks protect us, and those with whom we come into contact, from infection of COVID-19.
2. Masks **MUST** be worn during each competition element.
3. Masks are not required outdoors when you are at LEAST 6 feet apart
4. **PROPER USE** of masks are required. It should fit tightly enough that droplets so not escape around the edges. The mask must cover both nose and mouth.
5. IF you have ANY symptoms as designated by the CDC – do not come to the trial.
6. You will be asked questions upon signing in to the event:
  - #1 Have you had close contact with someone testing positive for Covid-19 within the past 14 days
  - #2 Do you, or someone you live with have any of these symptoms:  
Fever, Cough, or respiratory distress?
7. Exhibitors must supply their own food and water
8. Hand sanitizer will be available for use. Please wash and sanitize hands often
9. Judges and steward will use techniques and tools to avoid handling an exhibitor's belongings and leashes
10. Awards and ribbons will be available outdoors
11. Exhibitors should bring their own chairs.

**NOTE: WCOTC follows all State of Pennsylvania and CDC Guidelines  
IF you are not willing to be compliant with these Trial guidelines, you will be asked  
to leave and will not receive a refund.**

## **DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

## DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

### **Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club Delmont North Industrial Park Route 66 North, Delmont, PA 15626**

#### **From the West**

Take PA Turnpike to Exit 57 (Monroeville.) After tollbooth take far right exit ramp towards Murrysville. Follow Route 22 East through Murrysville to intersection with Route 66 (10.4 miles.) Take Route 66 North ramp to Delmont.

#### **\*\*\*From the intersection of Rt. 22 and Rt. 66:**

Continue north on Route 66 (2.9 miles) through two traffic lights, past Fletcher's Outdoor Power Equipment and Valero Century RV Sales on the left. Just after you pass the Delmont Veterinary Hospital on the left, turn RIGHT into driveway for the Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.

Route 66N from the Route 22 cloverleaf is a 45mph speed limit. At the Dairy Queen, it drops with no warning to 40mph-This is a SPEED TRAP-big time.

#### **From the South or East**

Take the PA Turnpike or Interstate 70 to the New Stanton interchange. Follow PA Toll Road 66 North to intersection with Route 22 (13.8 miles). Pass under Route 22 and follow directions from \*\*\*above.

#### **From the North**

Take Route 66 South. From the Route 380 intersection, continue 7 miles South. Past the blue VW sign for Excel Auto Body, turn left into Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.
