Head Varsity Coach: Jim DiGuiseppe, Jr. (23rd season)

Coach DiGuiseppe, Jr. is a graduate of Archbishop Wood High School. He is entering his 8th season as the Vikings Head Baseball Coach. He earned his B.S. from Delaware Valley University and M.S. from Villanova University. Coach "Dege" was a three-year starter at DVU. While playing for the Aggies, he was awarded Most Valuable Player and First Team All-Conference. Additionally, Coach played for Lansdale in the Perkiomen Valley League. During his tenure as the Vikings Head Baseball Coach, he has compiled an overall record of 111-44 and 61-23 in PCL play. Coach guided the Vikings to 4 straight District Championships (2014, 2015, 2016 & 2017), Division Championships in 2014 & 2015 and the PCL Championship in 2015.
