

# How many quick-relief inhalers\* do you REALLY need?

- Home
- Backup for School
- School / daycare
- Extra at home
- Travel bag
- Grandparents
- Athletics / activities

1. **Call your insurance company - ask which quick-relief inhalers are covered and at what co-pay (if any). Also, ask how many quick-relief inhalers you may have filled on one prescription (if there is a limit)**
2. **Ask your provider to write a prescription for the number of quick-relief inhalers needed.**

If you have WellCare® of Nebraska, a member can fill (3) ProAir® or Proventil® HFA inhalers at one time. Providers/Pharmacists need to put each inhaler as a 30-day supply. If you need a quick-relief inhaler other than the above, the Provider may submit a prior authorization for a quantity override.

*\* A quick-relief inhaler works immediately to relieve symptoms of asthma symptoms such as wheezing, coughing and shortness of breath.*
