Thelma Wright Youth Grant Program

Purpose

The Koinonia Foundation is a nondenominational Christian organization dedicated to spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ by serving those in need. In helping to accomplish its mission, The Koinonia Foundation has established a youth grant program. The purpose of these grants is to fund creative and innovative mission projects for individual youth and youth groups in the Greater Wake Forest, Rolesville, and Youngsville areas.

Eligibility

- The mission project or program must be driven in design and implementation by youth or youth groups (grades 6-12).
- The mission project must be completed in the Greater Wake Forest, Rolesville, or Youngsville communities.
- The mission project must identify with the charge of the Koinonia Foundation.
- The mission project should be one that has not been funded in previous years.
- Applications must be turned in by March 1st.

Supervision

If a group is applying for the grant there must be one youth from the group who acts as the representative for contact, interview, progress report presentation etc.

All groups and individuals applying for a grant must have authorization and supervision from an adult.

Interview & Approval Process

Once the application is received by the Koinonia Foundation it will be reviewed by the grant coordinator. If it is determined that the application meets the requirements set by the board, the applicant will be contacted by the grant coordinator to set up a personal interview with the applicant. After the interview

process, the board will make the final decision regarding approval and the dollar amount that will be awarded. The complete process can take up to two months.

Dollar Range of Grants

The maximum grant awarded per group or individual is \$1000.00.

Project Report & Presentation

Each individual or group receiving grant money will be responsible for completing and submitting a written project report to the Koinonia Foundation upon completion of the mission project. The written report should include a brief description of the work, completion date, and other interesting facts and information regarding the project. What you/your group learn from the experience? How did the experience make you/your group feel? How did the project further the Koinonia Foundation's goal of spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ to the community by serving those in need?

It is further agreed and acknowledged that the Koinonia Foundation may use any materials, tangible or intangible prepared by or generated as a result of the mission project as part of its promotional materials.
