[Silence from Gun Prohibitionists After Armed Citizen Stops Mall Shooter](#)

Once again, gun prohibition lobbying groups are locked in silence after a legally-armed 22-year-old intervened quickly to fatally shoot a would-be mass killer who opened fire at the Greenwood Park Mall in Greenwood, Ind., in an action police are hailing as heroic.

It is not the first time an armed private citizen has killed a killer. According to the FBI, last year armed citizens stopped six "active shooters." In four of those cases, the perpetrator was killed. In each case, the gun ban lobby was mum.

The Greenwood Mall killer reportedly had several loaded magazines for his rifle, described initially only as a "long rifle." It was not immediately known how many rounds he was able to fire before being shot dead by the unidentified armed citizen, who is also being variously described in reports as a "Good Samaritan" and "armed bystander."

According to the most recent report from the Crime Prevention Research Center, Indiana has more than 1.1 million active concealed carry permits, and now there are likely even more people carrying because of the Constitutional Carry law now in effect. That's more than 15 percent of the adult population, according to a map at the CPRC website.

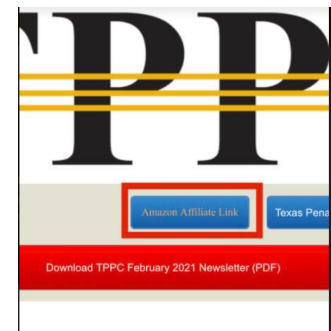
The AP reported the hero citizen hails from nearby Bartholomew County. There was no description of his sidearm.

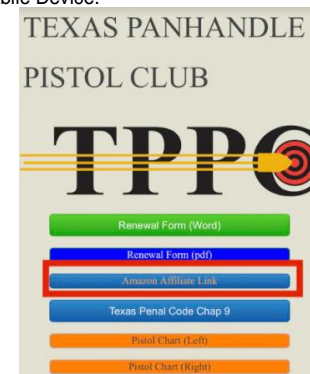

August's Shooting Drill – Bill Drill

The last few years I have provided many resources for Dry Firing practices due to the higher cost of ammo and the lack of availability. Now that that availability has come back, I'll start posting some shooting drills everyone should attempt.

From the low-ready & deliver 6 shots into the target from 7 yards. If using an IPSC silhouette, all six shots should be in the "A" zone. If using a smaller target, all six should be in the black field of an NRA bullseye, inside the 9-ring of other bullseye targets, or all inside a 6-inch paper plate.

This drill practices sight re-acquisition & recoil control, as well as discipline to not shoot without the correct sight picture.

[Assault Weapons Ban of 2022 Passes the House](#) Ammoland Inc. Posted on July 29, 2022 by John Crump

WASHINGTON, DC – After a long day in the U.S. House of Representatives, the Assault Weapons Ban of 2022 (H.R. 1808) passed mainly on a party-line vote by a count of 217 for to 214 against the bill.

The Democrats modified the House rules to allow for a vote on the "assault weapons" ban before leaving for their break. The Republicans strongly objected to the change of rules, but the Democrats brushed off their concerns. President Joe Biden has pushed for the ban since taking office.

The bill is headed to the Senate, where it will face an uphill battle. Republicans can filibuster the bill, and Democrats will need to convince ten Republicans to cross the aisle. There is no time frame for the bill to be taken up by the Senate.
