



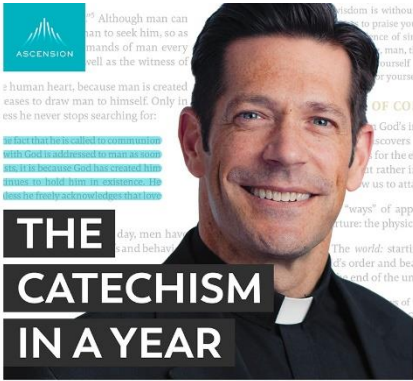

VIOLENCE AGAINST THE CHURCH

Hundreds of Roman Catholic Churches have been attacked since the violence following George Floyd's death in May 2020, according to a Catholic nonprofit.

Since May 2020 there have been nearly 300 attacks against U.S. Catholic churches as far away as Emmonak, Alaska.

The religious nonprofit organization noted that "while the riots and looting mostly died down in the summer of 2020, the attacks on Catholic churches have continued and escalated."

The attacks also include, broken windows, decapitated statues and satanic graffiti. Some 118 incidents were logged after the May 2022 leak of the draft Supreme Court decision in Dobbs v. Jackson's Health Organization, which overturned Roe v. Wade's federal abortion protections. While some of the attacks involved theft, the "vast majority" of recorded incidents were simply destruction of private property, which the group said indicates "that the primary motive is not material gain."

A report released in December 2022 also found that church attacks spiked following the overturning of Roe v. Wade. The same report attributes the attacks to "a collapse in societal reverence and respect for house of worship and religion – in this case churches and Christianity."
