



FEAST OF ST. LUKE, OCTOBER18 There are only a few certain facts about St. Luke's life. We know him best as the author of the third gospel and of the Acts of the Apostles. A Greek himself, he wrote the story of Jesus and the Christian community for Gentile readers. Demonstrating an unusual commitment to accuracy, he appears to have fastidiously checked his facts. He aimed his books to persuade Gentiles that the Christian story was true. So he made it more accessible to them by filing his gospel with accounts of Christ's openness and mercy. Tradition says Luke lived a long life without marrying and that he died at age eighty-four.
