Aloha Kakou,

Years ago, in the mid-1990s, I believe, I read that more words had been penned about Martin Luther, than anyone else in history except Jesus. I was impressed. Remember, this was when personal computers and the Internet were in their infancy. That was a lot of books, magazine articles, and academic papers.

Then, a few years ago, in the 20-teens, I read that more words had been typed on social media and blogs since 2004 than had been written in all of previous human history. Martin Luther was nowhere mentioned, and even Jesus received only a nod. Now, that is a lot of social media comments and blogging!

More recently, I have been listening online to a lot more people arguing about what the "Word of God" means. More words. Lots of words. Lots of angry words. "Repent!" and "Heretic!" were two of the more common words. People seem to have a great deal invested in their positions, especially those who shout the loudest about the Bible being the Word of God.

Allow me to share with you a few observations that have been with the orthodox Lutheran Movement for centuries:

- The Bible is the manger and swaddling clothes of Christ (Luther).
- The Bibe was written by a large number of people, writing for different reasons.
- The Bible is the canonical scriptures of the Old and New Testaments.

- The Bible is the word of God and reveals the Word of God, Jesus Christ.
- Jesus Christ is the lens through whom we read the Bible.
- The proclamation of Law and Gospel is the word of God.
- The Bible is inspired by God.
- Some people read the Bible as literal and inerrant. Some people read the Bible as an interesting ancient text, but not as scripture. Lutherans, and many other Christians, read the bible as a Living Word, using the tools of Biblical criticism.
- For any presentation of a Bible text, it's important to ask whether it reveals the God of love.





It is with a sad heart that we bid farewell to Pastor A.J.


We thank him for his service to CLC and wish him well as he accepts a call to St. Michaels Lutheran Church in Wellington, Florida
