

ANNOUNCEMENT

Three month trial period beginning - 10.10.2018

As per Monday's Community Meeting it was announced that certain changes in our Rules and Regulations would not be considered violations. Approval of these changes will be subject to a vote in our January Community Meeting. This trial period will be a continuation that started May of this year, 2018. Not everyone is aware of what they actually are, and that they've been permitted under a trial basis. After three months trial, at our next Annual meeting in January, these will be presented for vote in order to change how they're listed in our written governing documents. They are as follows:

1. Automobiles will be permitted to be parked overnight, perpendicular (sideways) in a DOUBLE driveway as long as no wheels are touching the road. Driving on the grass is prohibited. Back-in parking, as you would do on the public roads, may be necessary. This is not to be misconstrued as a new parking spot, but only as a temporary parking option for a third visiting auto and only in cases where it's appropriate due to driveway dimensions. (not permitted in single driveways)
2. Motorcycles, under certain conditions, will not be violated for being left in your driveway overnight. Many use their MoCy's more than one day at a time. Of course there are guidelines to this also, which may be obtained from the office. These include:
 - a. MoCy must have a proper dark colored 'MoCy' cover.
 - b. It must be positioned against the garage door.
 - c. You must have an alternate 'Permanent' parking spot for your MoCy when not in use. * Abuse will be subject to revocation.
3. Plastic utility bins on the side of your home will be permitted if it is not larger than three feet deep to the wall, five feet wide and four feet high. It must have a lid that is always closed. It may not be used for garbage pail storage.
