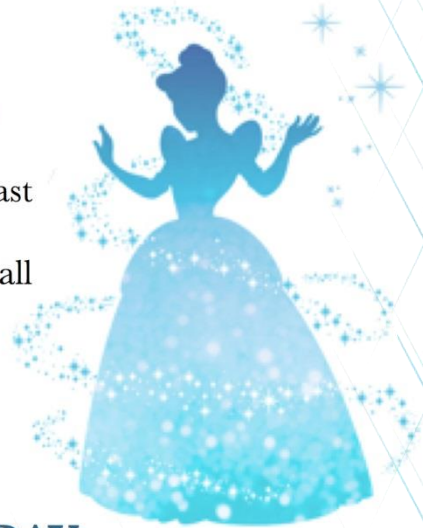
Project Cinderella

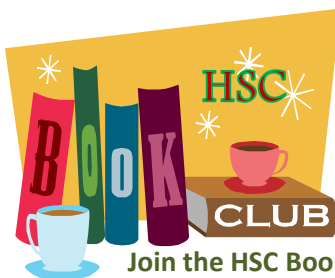

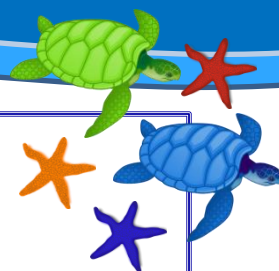
