



WALNUT STREET BRIDGE


Before Norfork Dam opened in 1944, Calico Creek flooded every spring. Sometimes East Calico buildings had water up to their ceilings. August 20, 1915, Willy Gainer wrote, Walnut Street "bridge washed out, sidewalks in lower part of town (East Calico) all afloat."


An earlier wooden wagon bridge was suspended from overhead cables. A railing divided foot traffic from horses, mules and wagons. In 1948 when a new bridge was to be installed on Highway 56 over Piney Creek, the old bridge was loaded on two flatbed trucks placed end to end. One truck drove forward and the other backward to bring it here. After this bridge was set it in place, the roadbed was rebuilt with wood and steel.
