COMMITTEE REPORT~

POST ACTIVITIES-CHARLIE FONTANA REPORTED THAT THE COLUMBUS DAY DANCE WAS SUCCESSFUL AND RETURNED A PROFIT OF \$250. CHARLIE POINTED OUT THAT IN ADDITION TO THE MONETARY PROFIT, THE COMMITTEE MAKES SURE THERE IS PLENTY OF BEER AND SODA LEFT OVER WHICH IS SERVE ON MEETING NIGHTS. CHARLIE THEN WENT OVER THE POST CHRISTMAS PROGRAM: DEC 9-POST MEMBER'S CHRISTMAS PARTY, DEC 18-CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARTY AND ON DEC. 31-THE NEW YEAR'S PARTY AT \$35 PER PERSON. MOTION MADE THAT POST PAY THE MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR BOTH CHARLES FONTANA AND RICHARD REICHART BECAUSE OF THE EXTRAORDINARY SERVICES THEY PERFORM FOR THE POST AND THE CORPORATION. MOTION SECONDED AND PASSED.

MEMBERS FAMILIES NOTIFYING THEM OF THE MASS. REFRESHMENTS AFTER THE MASS WILL BE SERVED AT CESPINO-RUSSO POST.
