

*MINUTES OF MEETING OF NOVEMBER. 11 1994*

*MEETING CONVENED AT 8:30 PM. COMMANDER LEO MILHAM PRESIDING.  
THERE WERE 29 MEMBERS PRESENT.*

*THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF OCTOBER 14, 1995 WERE ACCEPTED  
AS READ.*

*COMMITTEE REPORT~*

*HOSPITAL VISITATION- COMMANDER MILHAM REPORTED THAT BILLY CHANG UNDERWENT A KIDNEY  
REMOVAL OPERATION AND IS NOW AT HOME. ALSO REPORTED THAT MIKE SHANE'S SON HAD PASSED  
AWAY IN RHODE ISLAND. FRIUT BASKETS WERE SENT BY THE POST TO BOTH BILLY AND MIKE.*

*MEMBERSHIP-CHARLIE FONTANA REPORTED THAT WE HAVE 183 MEMBERS  
THAT HAVE RENEWED THEIR DUES. WE NEED 61 MORE TO REACH LAST  
YEARS TOTAL OF 244*

*POST ACTIVITIES-CHARLIE FONTANA REPORTED THAT THE COLUMBUS DAY DANCE WAS SUCCESSFUL  
AND RETURNED A PROFIT OF \$250. CHARLIE POINTED OUT THAT IN ADDITION TO THE MONETARY  
PROFIT, THE COMMITTEE MAKES SURE THERE IS PLENTY OF BEER AND SODA LEFT OVER WHICH IS  
SERVED ON MEETING NIGHTS. CHARLIE THEN WENT OVER THE POST CHRISTMAS PROGRAM: DEC 9-POST  
MEMBER'S CHRISTMAS PARTY, DEC 18-CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARTY AND ON DEC. 31- THE NEW YEAR'S  
PARTY AT \$35 PER PERSON. CHARLIE ALSO INFORMED THE POST THAT THE WOMEN'S AUXILIARY WAS  
DONATING \$100 TOWARDS THE CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARTY AND \$100 TOWARDS THE PURCHASE OF  
FOOD BASKETS THAT WILL BE DONATED TO NEEDY FAMILIES AT CHRISTMAS. COMMANDER MILHAM  
REQUESTED THAT MEMBERS DONATE CAN FOODS OR MONEY TO BE USED FOR THE FOOD BASKETS.*

*VETERAN'S DAY CEREMONY-COMMANDER LEO MILHAM REPORTED THAT THE POST HONOR GUARD LED  
THE MARCH TO THE PODIUM WITH THE COUNTY COLORS. THE PROGRAM WENT WELL AND WE HAD ABOUT  
8 POST MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE. UNFORTUNATELY AGAIN, THERE WAS A DISPUTE AS TO  
WHICH HONOR GUARD WOULD LEAD THE MARCH. MARK CURESELLE OVER- RULED THE CHAIRMAN  
GEORGE GUERIERRO AND DESIGNATED OUR POST HONOR GUARD TO CARRY THE COLORS. AS RESULT  
GEORGE RESIGNED AS CHAIRMAN AND LEFT.*

*TREASURER-PAT MESERINDINO REPORTED AN OPENING BALANCE OF \$470.83 AT THE LAST  
MEETING. SUBSEQUENT TO THE MEETING, INCOME WAS \$2670.00 AND EXPENSES WERE \$2433.54  
LEAVING A BALANCE OF \$707.33.*

*OLD BUSINESS- FERDIE SALVATORE REPORTED THAT HE CONTACTED LEE CORVINO AND THE VETERAN'S  
HOSPITAL TO OBTAIN THE ADDRESS TO SEND THE \$50 DONATION TO THE STATEN ISLAND VA CLINIC AND  
WAS NOT ABLE TO GET AN ADDRESS.*

NEW BUSINESS-

*MOTION MADE THAT POST PAY THE MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR BOTH CHARLES FONTANA AND RICHARD REICHART BECAUSE OF THE EXTRAORDINARY SERVICES THEY PERFORM FOR THE POST AND THE CORPORATION. MOTION SECONDED AND PASSED.*

*THE COUNTY LEGION IS HOLDING A MASS AT THE HOLY ROSARY CHURCH IN SOUTH BEACH AT 10 AM ON DEC. 4, 1994 FOR LEGION MEMBERS WHO HAVE DIED THIS YEAR. A LIST OF DECEASED MEMBERS FROM OUR POST SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE CHAIRMAN AT THE NEXT COUNTY MEETING. PHIL FRAZZETTO SAID HE WOULD WRITE LETTERS TO THE DECEASED MEMBERS FAMILIES NOTIFYING THEM OF THE MASS. REFRESHMENTS AFTER THE MASS WILL BE SERVED AT CESPINO-RUSSO POST.*
