除此之外,協康會亦舉辦其它家庭同 樂活動,包括節日聯歡、聚餐、旅行 和宿營等,在這一年來,我們一家便 參加了春節和復活節郊遊、母親節聯 歡、冬季宿營和每月的生日會等。隨後 協康會還會舉辦父親節郊遊、中秋節聯 歡暨聚餐和聖誔節聯歡等。透過這些活 動,不但可以聯繫家人感情,增添生活 樂趣,更可以認識其它家長,爲了加強 家長間的溝通,協康會還組織了「媽媽 休閒站」和「爸爸對對碰」組,讓家長 定期聚曾,彼此交流經驗。協康會舉辦 的其它活動,還包括資訊性的健康講 座、電腦應用和急救訓練等,家長和孩 子均獲益良多。


# Music therapy 音樂治療班 & Movement Class 體能動作班



## Performance at the Evening Dinner of Lions Club of Sydney Waratah

The performance was extraordinarily good! The audience enthusiastically clapped their hands loudly; some women were even so moved that tears slid down from the corners of their eyes.

It should be a cold night around this time of the year. Did it turn out to be a warm, or even hot night?! Or was it because I worried the children might make mistakes? I sweated all night!!! However, the children did not lose their beat throughout. Oh! It was a brilliant performance!!!

Earlier in the afternoon, we arrived at the Belmore Senior Citizens Centre for the final rehearsal. At 2:30pm, there were still not many children arriving. I really had a little bit of worry that there might not be enough people for the rehearsal; however, they were just late, not absent.

Because they would have a totally live performance, they didn't need me to

play the recorded music. So, I had the free time to have yet another Dad-to-Dad "meeting" in the smaller room! No! It was just a friendly chat among 7 to 8 fathers! We talked on topics from the sickness of our children, the services available to disabled children, our own insomnia and how to cure it, to the fear and worry about Facebook and the Microsoft products as a whole, which meant the Windows Live in the current case... while leaving our wives in the big room to guide the children practising.

At around 5:30pm, our army started our long march to the City! After Darby instructed us on the quickest way to go to our destination, and our discussion of how to move all the musical instruments to the performance platform upon arrival, the sky had nearly been completely dark! My car lost the main troop on the way near Marrickville. While being stuck at a heavy traffic jam in Newton due to the Saturday night fever, I had my

round of worry!

Anyway, my family and I arrived just 10 minutes later than planned. Then, all things went smoothly! After having an expecting but leisured dinner at the Market City food court, our whole team moved across the road to the venue at the Marigold Restaurant at around 7:50pm.

The scheduled starting time of our performance was at 8:00pm. Because the venue is small, only about half of the parents could go up to take care of the children, while the other half of disappointing parents were deserted in the lift lobby on the ground floor to have their dessert: eating wind! The elevator door closed with their children behind it. The elevator then took their children away from them to go upstairs.

However, their sacrifice was not futile:The performance turned out to be a stunning success!



# Parent Support Group —Report 2: 23 May 2009 Saturday 2.30 to 3.30 pm

Facilitator: Betty Li

Topics: Communication by means of Makaton and Pictures, Potty training – teach them to wipe their bottoms, Preparation for the start of menstruation for girls.

- We had printed out some makaton signs and pictures for the parents to learn to make signs for communication with their children
- As children are being toilet trained, parents also share some of the responsibility for hygiene. Children need help with wiping their bottom, and show them how and explain to little girls that they need to wipe from front to back.
- 3. One way to give the child practice in wiping her/his bottom is: put some moisturizing cream on the child's bottom and give her/him the toilet tissue to wipe it off. Keep practicing it until the child is familiar with the procedures. Do get them into the important habit of hand washing.
- 4. We had discussion on the topic of "menstruation" and some parents had given their valuable ideas and experience in helping their girls to cope with Menstruation.

# 智障人士的轉機 - 實現自主自決的生活

服務特殊教育已一段日子,還記得每日早上,總可以聽到學生向我們問安。這群與一般兒童及少年人無異,都喜愛笑和玩耍。唯一不同的,是他們的智商比一般人低,所以有稱他們是智障或弱能人士類別中的一種。

#### 脫不了的『智障』形像

#### 智障人士『改變形像』的契機

大多數海外的特殊教育方向,都以學生在離校後獲得優質生活為目標。筆者跟據香港聖雅各布福群會在九九年對輕度智障成人生活質會在九九年對輕度智障成人生活質於之一。 『受訪智障人士的資料顯示: 『受訪智障人士會觀然不足。受訪者雖然有日常生活及自我照顧決定權,但在金錢選擇,工作選擇,談戀愛及結婚等選擇,則極大部份由家人為決定。』該報告建議智障人士的家人可按智障成員的情況,在日常生活中培養他們自決的能力。

提升智障人士的生活質素,筆者確 信先要提升他們的『自我』,因此 發展他們的『自主,自決』能力是重要不過的,要達致『自主,自決』需要掌握一定的策略,據資料『自我決策』可分為以下八項技能:選擇,作決定,解難,定目標,自我管理,自我肯定,自我認識,自我操控

(WehmeyerSchalock, 2001).



#### 個案實錄

根據筆者的經驗,發展智障人士『自主自決』的能力,實能深深的影響他們的生活。以下來自香港的個案,是生活中真實的故事。

亞寧是一個輕度智障的高中學生,在學校裏,她學到自己作決定,解決事情要開會商討。所以她要向媽媽提議,開家庭會議解決家庭問題。亞寧眼見同學每天帶午膳回校,於是,她向媽媽提出不在定飯盒。媽媽認為若她能自己每天準備午餐,那麼,就取消在校訂午膳。亞寧最終決定自己每天準備午膳,她戰戰兢兢地向老師申請,至高中畢業,亞寧還繼續自己負責自己的午餐。

華仔是一個有自閉症的輕度智障學生,剛升到高中,老師教導他為自己定立目標,華仔與媽媽商量後,定出兩項目標,其一是把中文字體書寫細一點,好讓文字能整齊地寫在方格內。由於華仔寫字都字字出格,力度十足,老師相信華仔要達成目標,必需花上好一段時間。出乎意料地,經老師提醒他的學習目標,加上示範的

字樣,雖然華仔的改變不能就此歸 因於『他為自己定立目標』,但老 師卻能藉此鼓勵,讚賞華仔,而建 立他的自信心。

#### 關注身邊弱能人士的真正需要

今天身處在澳洲的弱能人士,都能享有一定的福利,各方面的需要都得到適當的照顧。澳洲政府(http://www.aph.gov.au/library/intguide/SP/disabilit.htm#links)為弱能群體提供不同的支援,對於自閉症人士,Austism Spectrum Australia (http://www.aspect.org.au/default.asp#logo)也提供相關的資源和服務。華人社群中,也自發組織了『澳洲弱能兒童協康會』Chinese Parents Association-Children with Disabilities Inc.

(www.chineseparents.org), 為弱能人士 及其家人提供服務。這個弱能人士 家長組織,對培訓弱能人士不遺餘 力。參與的家長及義工,定期每星 期都為不同年齡的弱能人士提供訓 練課程及興趣班。

教導一個普通的兒童尚且不輕易, 何況是養育弱能的孩子。眼見每星 期家長從或近或遠的地方,帶著孩 子到來參加活動,父母愛子女之心 可見一斑。

深信生命本身就有其價值,並且有它的意義。筆者相信除了為弱能人士提供物質生活需要外,家人與社會人士對他們的期望與態度也很重要。給他們一點信心與尊重,讓弱能人士實踐『自主自決』的生活,使他們能有重新估量自己的能力。同時,讓社會大眾也能從一個新角度瞭解他們。

# Handling Sex problem with People with Disabilities Seminar Report 1:

### Accessing the Sex Industry for People with An Intellectual Disability

Accessing the Sex Industry for people with an Intellectual Disability was conducted by People with Disability Australia (PWD) presented by Denise Beckwith on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2009. It was sponsored by DADHC and held in their Parramatta office.

There were about fifteen people including the speaker. Some were from various departments in DADHC and some from other service providers or community organisations including myself. The objective of the workshop was to discuss the need of sex industry for disability services and how to access sexual services.

The meeting kicked off assuming sex, which had a broad base meaning of any activity relating to sexuality (not necessary conducting intercourse particularly), being an unavoidable need for people with disability and the discussion extended to disadvantaged people. The PWD introduced part of their services, Touching Base Inc., which had a pool of sex workers males and females who were willing to assist those people to release their urges. These included homosexuals and bisexuals as well as people with physical disability. Little had been said about the after effects of the acts to the users except saying that they would

bring confidence to them. Not much was said as to what kind of signs shown by those people would be in need of such service. But it was necessary to obtain consensus from the disabled before calling for service and it was important to consult with professional such as psychologist. In fact, Medicare rebate might be possible with professional's referral.

Questions were raised about how sex workers handling various difficulties such as people with physical disability or people with challenging behaviour, the speaker indicated that sex workers could deal those problems quite well. Whether there might be psychological problems after the service, it would be best to consult with professionals afterwards.

I must stress that this service is not about how to develop relationship and intimacy. The parents with power of attorney can only control the finance of their children but not their right of having sex.

PWD is a national disability rights and advocacy organisation. It is a non-profit, non-government organisation.

### 處理弱能人士性愛問題討論會報告(一): 弱能人士與性服務



六月十九日週五開的弱能人士接獲性服務討論會是由 澳洲弱能人士協會(PWD)的Denise Beckwith 主持。也 是由巴拉瑪打Parramatta DADHC 贊助的。

參會者連主持在內共有十五人。多位是DADHC 機构內部人,另外有其他服務團體的工作人員和包括我在內的社團人士。討論會的主要目標是探討弱能人士如何接獲性服務。

這個討論會一開始就假定「性」(無論是任何有關性的言語動作,並非一定是性交)畢竟是弱能人士需要的,這也包括那些社區弱勢人士在內。 PWD 特別介紹他們的一個叫Touching Basis Inc 的部門。這個部門有一群願意爲弱能人士提供性服務的男女性工作職員。職員中有同性戀的、異性戀的以及有殘障的。至于有關用者接受性服務後的效果反應,除了會增強個人自信外,其他便別無所提。也沒有提到弱能人士需要這種

性服務時的最常表達的預告徵像。但強調在要求提供 性服務之前,須得該弱能人士的同意,最好有心理專家 診斷。事實是若得到心理醫師的批核,或者可從醫保中 得到回扣。

問題談論到有關從事性服務者如何應對各種弱能人士或 有挑戰性行爲的人,Denise 說他們都能當機立斷,應 付有餘。事後最好有專家作心理分析,以防有心理後遺 症。

我強調一點就是這種服務不是有關如何培養情感和親密關係(可能在下一個研討再談)。 父母雖有法律上的 "授權書" (Power of Attorney),但紙能限於管理他們子女的金錢運用而不能管制兒女的有性行為的權利。 PWD 是一個全國弱能人權和擁護喉舌集團。是一個非營利的私人集團。

### Handling Sex Problem with People with Disabilities

#### Relationship and "Private Stuff"

Relationships & "Private Stuff" was the second seminar regarding to sexual problems for people with disabilities conducted by Liz Dore sponsored by DADHC.

Liz is a relationships counsellor supporting people with a disability to develop meaningful friendship and a positive awareness of their sexuality. She has long experience dealing and educating disable people in the past.

The attendants were from various service providers such as Studio Arts, Frans, Sunshine Homes, DSA, AC Foundation, House with no steps, Sunnyfield and Westley. Many of them were experienced carers.

Liz started the meeting with video clips from "Love and Kisses" which showed interviews of people with disability talking in single or with a partner about some sexual and relationship experiences and expectations. Most subjects could express fairly well themselves. One of the subjects has mobility problem and one father was also interviewed. These clips were interesting and educational to young people as well.

Liz then handed out a list of cases for us to study in groups of two or three. The following Cases were just some examples:

- Anne lived alone. She wanted to have relationship with her driver.
- 2. Brian bribed a girl to touch his private part
- 3. Chris showed affection to his carer
- Ilija was charged with indecent exposure and had sex in public with same sex partner

Carers were asked how to handle in each case. Liz dissected with each group whether IDRS (Intellectually Disability Rights Service) or CISN (Criminal Justice Support Network) were needed when police and legal representation would be required. When professional assistance and guardians were needed and what kind of investigations needed to follow. Questions or information about consent, safe sex, and abuse must be detailed in reports.

Finally, Liz touched on sex education materials such as Family Planning booklets and some other books and videos as well as sex aids. Unfortunately there was shortage of time to cover helping young people to develop relationship and communication skills and protective behaviours. Liz spent a little bit of time to show some dolls for the girls to learn about their body changes which may be good for parents to help their daughters.

# 處理弱能人士性愛問題討論會報告(二)

## 探討情感關係和『隱私事物』



處理弱能人士性愛問題的第二個研討會是探討情感關係和『隱私事物』。這次會議是由 麗絲. 桃 Liz Dore女士主持。也是由巴拉瑪打Parramatta DADHC 贊助的。

麗絲Liz 女士是一位支援弱能人士的情感關係輔導專家,協助弱能者了解認識富有意義的情誼和對性方面 正確的認識。她有多年應付和教育弱能人士對性問題 的經驗。

參會者大約共有二十人。都是對弱能服務供應團體的工作人員,如 Studio Arts, Frans, Sunshine Homes, DSA, AC Foundation, House with No Steps, Sunnyfield 和 Westley。多數是有經驗的年青照顧人員。

麗絲Liz 女士在會議開頭放了『愛情和接吻』"Love and Kisses" 影片錄像中幾段訪問,其中有個人和一對弱能人士對性的經驗和期望。 差大多所有的主角都能清楚表達他們自己。其中有一位人士是行動不方便,另一位是一個弱能者的父親。這幾段對年青的弱能者都是有趣而有教育性的。

然後,麗絲Liz 女士拿出了幾條實際性的研究例子,我們每二、三人分組討論。以下是其中幾個例子:

- 1 安妮獨居。她想與她的司機結交
- 2 白來恩行賄小女孩幫他按摩下體
- 3 克力士對他的男性照顧工作者有感情
- 4 依刺家犯非禮暴露罪和在公眾塲所與同性伴侶性交

在這些情況下照顧工作者要如處理每一個例子。麗絲 Liz 女士幫助每一組解析在某種情况下需要警察和法律代表在場的時侯,可以利用弱智人士人權服務處 IDRS (Intellectually Disability Rights Service) 或者刑事司法扶助處 CJSN (Criminal Justice Support Network)。更分析到需要怎樣調查,或者職業專家和家人在場。對於許可承諾,安全性交或強暴侵凌都要有詳盡記錄。

最後麗絲Liz 女士示範很多性教書本和影片錄像盤以及性教工具。可惜這次會議僅有四小時,不能提到如何幫助年青人發展感情,溝通技巧和安全性交。麗絲Liz 女士再拿出幾隻洋娃娃來幫助給弱智女士做性教育示範,有助父母認識如何對女兒解譯人體的成長變化。

### 自閉兒的青春期

『偉賢的自閉症,可能是上天對我們一家的祝福,可不是麼?因為他,丈夫和我每天準時下班,為的是回去訓練他的眼神接觸、語言和其他社交行為。弟弟偉強也學會諒解家人,一起照顧哥哥,一家人總是和洽相處。倘若沒有他,我想我會埋首工作,每天到晚上八、九時才下班;丈夫也不會好得多,因為他是工作狂...』在一次家長分享會上,婉嫻對幾十個自閉兒的家長說。她的話令其他家長共鳴,不少人眼泛淚光,照顧一個自閉兒,陪伴著他成長,的確是件了不起的工作。偉賢快十歲了,在特殊學校唸四年級。

他終於學會了控制大小便,書包裹也不用放套替換的衣服。婉嫻和丈夫為兒子的成就興奮得一夜也睡不著。夫婦倆躺在床上。半晌,婉嫻對丈夫說: 『老公,偉賢真行,他可以控制大小便了。』

丈夫回應: 『是啊,我盼了很久,這天終 於到來,我想我們該出去吃頓飯慶祝一 下...』

偉賢被老師發現有特殊才能, 他計數很

快,視覺記憶也很強,很複雜的數學題他也可以輕鬆做好。另一方面,他見過的風景,可以準確地畫出來,所有細節、色彩和前後的空間也準確如照片,就像一幅超現實的風景畫,連畫裏的蝴蝶也栩栩如生。

他開始畫畫以後,便再沒法停下來,每天也在畫,有時 上課也在畫,作品超過百幅,老師為他在學校搞了個小 型展覽,家長們看見無不感到驚訝。

看著偉賢的作品,婉嫻感動極了,他對丈夫說: 『偉賢是個天才,是個藝術家,若不是老師細心,他的天才就會給埋沒了。現在多好,他喜歡畫畫,作品拿去參加比賽又多次獲獎,還賣出了幾幅,看來這個孩子可以自食其力,不用我們太操心...』

丈夫緊握著婉嫻的手顫抖著,太感動了,他說不出話來。

他們對偉賢的期望提高了,痛苦也開始了,為了令偉賢 學習更多繪畫技法。他們送偉賢到各種藝術學校,希望 他可以多學一點不同的技術,然而,無論到哪裏跟誰學 藝,他的畫風永遠都是老樣子。

升中了,偉賢的行為令他們頭痛,當他看見衣著性感的女士,便會目不轉睛地看著對方,臉上出現奇怪的笑容,然後把雙手伸進褲裹握弄自己的生殖器,有時,他太興奮、太得意忘形,居然把生殖器拿出來把玩... (待續)

#### 他的未來

偉賢雖然是個自閉兒,他的生理發展卻非常正常。最初,他對女士很感興趣,甚至在公眾地方刺激自己。經過專家們的治療,花了半年時間,他學會了到自己的房間去手淫。

他對班裏的一位女同學著迷,每天提早十五分鐘上學去,為的是可以繞到她家,和她一起步行上學去。一位含羞答答的女生走在前面,他則緊跟在後,沒有身體接觸,也沒有說話,唯兩人步伐一致,一眼便看出他們的關系。

婉嫻擔心,偉賢可能會跟他愛戀的女生有性 接觸,想教他如何使用安全套,但不知如何 開口,爸爸只好把安全套的說明書放在偉賢 的書桌上。第二天,一件令他們哭笑不得的 生情發生了,老師打電話給婉嫻,告訴她偉 賢把任何戴安全套的圖畫準確地畫在畫紙 上,令老師大為緊張,卻不肯定他是否已懂 得使用安全套。

爸爸找來一段戴上安全套,然後做愛的影片 讓偉賢看,他沒有說話,卻把影片中幾個精

彩的鏡頭畫了下來,還把那些書放進書包裹。過了幾 天,爸爸發現偉賢在自己的房間練習戴上安全套,但兩 個人的關系需要互相尊重,雙方同意方可做愛的概念則 不知如何教他。

弟弟偉強教偉賢玩聯線游戲,偉賢看了一會,坐下來便 沒法停止,他不住的搜索,射擊。一小時後,他已拿到 游戲的最高分。網上一個又一個的游戲也給他『打爆』 了,甚至贏了一臺電腦回家。不久,電腦游戲設計公司 聘用他為打機員,每月有數千元收入,可是錢對他來說 并沒有意義。

為什麼他會精於電腦游戲呢?大概他只有邏輯思維,而 電腦游戲也是以邏輯來設計的,他的腦袋運作跟電腦可 能有幾分相似。

在特殊學校唸到中三,他的學校生活便完結。他要到訓練中心接受培訓,可培訓完畢又往那裏去呢?似乎沒有人知道答案。因為自閉兒成長之後,便沒有相應的服務幫助他們。有人會整天呆在家裏浪費光陰,有人去了庇護工場或智障宿舍,也有人給送到精神病房去。

偉賢已經很幸運,離校之後,他可以到游戲設計公司去 『打機』,他的收入足夠他花費,可以算是自食其力。 婉嫻希望可以一直照顧偉賢,然而,她總有老死的一 天,弟弟偉強也會有自己的家庭。父母不在,偉賢會到 那裏去?這問題正困擾著有個成年自閉兒的父母。 (完)

## Fight for disabled is a matter of principals

Public school principals are so fed up with the neglect of children with disabilities in public schools they are preparing to sue the NSW Education Department for breaching anti-discrimination laws. This is no idle threat. Principals say they will happily bankrupt their professional association, the <a href="Public Schools Principals">Public Schools</a> <a href="Principals">Principals</a> is Forum to pursue the department through the courts.

I can't remember another time when NSW principals were so determined to confront a government on behalf of their students.

There have been many promises and millions allocated in budgets but like many things in NSW schooling \_ announcements are made but nothing much happens.

This week's State budget allocated another \$51 million to children with disabilities. However *The Daily Telegraph* could not get much detail as to how this would be spent apart from vague references to student transport, integration and special classes and schools.

Today there are over 30,000 special needs children in NSW public schools including children integrated into mainstream classes, in special schools and in special classes. NSW Public schools are responsible for educating about 85 per cent of children with disabilities in the state.

But teachers and parents know there are thousands more who have not been diagnosed or yet won the battle to be recognised and supported.

So I applaud principals for taking a stand.

Whenever a specific case is mentioned in the media funds magically

appear for that particular child - but the system-wide battle continues.

Principals are also hoping to spark a parliamentary inquiry into the schooling of special needs children in public schools later this year with the help of an unlikely alliance between the Greens and the NSW Liberal Party.

Frankly I look forward to the court case and the inquiry running at the same time. Particularly as there will be no settling out of court - which is the usual way the Education Department handles discrimination cases brought against it.

Meanwhile the push from the education department has been to integrate special needs children into mainstream classes. The idea is good. It is a choice most parents want for their children with disabilities. Everyone benefits when it is done properly.

The trouble is NSW never did it properly.

I have been writing this column the whole time it has been a policy and I can report there was never any real attempt to properly fund and support integration.

I try hard not to be cynical but I believe integration was always a cheap option for the government. It meant less money spent on special classes and specialist teachers.

Also parents and teachers have had to fight for disabilities such as autism, dyspraxia and aspergers to be recognised and supported - however inadequately.

And the Education Department has held everyone at bay by enforcing rigid classifications and staffing formulas.

Schools and teachers have to apply every year for many children \_ whose conditions have not changed \_ to continue to be funded.

But what was unforeseen was the huge blow-out of numbers of children diagnosed with disabilities and the extension of the range of recognised disabilities children may have.

Some children with Autism Spectrum Disorder, for example, get as little as \$605 a semester or 12 minutes of support time by an aide per day.

Often mainstream classes have several children with disabilities, each with very specific and different needs. It is totally unreasonable to expect a teacher to prepare and teach them without intense specialist support.

But the principals are most angry about how disadvantaged families miss out. Families who understand the system and are tenacious can often get funding for their children while other families have no chance. It can be a double whammy for children with parents who also have problems or disabilities.

The PSPF has identified around 2500 children who get no funding at all or the level of support is so low is it is ``seriously inadequate".

These children and their families do not represent a block of votes. Looking after them will probably get no extra votes for Labor. But if the court case rolls in and the inquiry gets up, NSW voters will lose even more confidence \_ if that is possible \_ in the current government's ability to look after their children.

# 秉持原則- 為弱能人士爭取支援

由於新南威爾斯州教育部不斷 忽視對公立學校的弱能兒童之 不平待遇,校長們感到十分厭 煩和灰心,準備提出控訴教育 部侵犯反岐視法例,這不是空 談,他們不惜以破斧沉舟的態 度,就算本身職業團體破產亦 在所不惜。

在記憶中,從來沒有這樣的事情發生過,校長們會爲學 生們出頭與教育部對抗。

從過往財政預算案中,對新南威爾斯州學校宣怖有多數 次的承諾及撥款,不過多是空談,罕有實際行動。

這星期的新州預算案中,弱能兒童有五千一百萬元津 貼。可是在*每日郵報* 所得的資料,除了學生交通和綜合 特別班外,其他的分配都是不明朗。

目前新州公校有超過三萬名兒童有特殊需要,其中包括 兒童將會溶匯入主流班次,特殊學校或特殊班。八成半 的弱能兒童教育重擔就落在新州公校的肩頭上。但教師 和家長們都明白,還有很多的兒童還未被判斷爲弱能, 或未被承認和支持。

#### 校長此舉值得擊掌。

奇怪的是,如有個別事件被傳媒喧染後,津貼會神奇地 出現於當事者的戶口中 - 但整個制度的爭取鬥爭仍持 續中。

校長們也希望在今年底,能有新州自由黨和綠黨的支持 (不太有可能的聯盟),在議會中,提出諮詢有關公校 兒童的特殊需要。

坦白的說,我期待著法庭的審訊和諮詢能同步進行。不 要庭外和解 - 因這是教育部通常用的處理手法,尤其 是當它被控訴歧視時。

教育部推行將弱能兒童融入主流班次,意見很好,對大 部分弱能兒童的家長們來說是歡迎的選擇。按照計劃, 正確處理推行,人人受益。 問題是新州政府從來都不曾正確地把此提議推行。

長期以來我在此專欄寫作,成爲一種工作上的策略,我可以說政府從來沒有任何具體的嘗試,及正當地處理撥款或支持將弱能兒童融入主流班的行動。

我盡力排除極端的想法,但相信融入主流班的做法 是政府最廉宜的選擇。用意是減少在特殊班和專業 師資上的開支。

家長和教師都爲弱能兒童如自閉症等爭取認同和支 持,但可惜仍不夠充分。

教育部運用其嚴格的分類法及教職員分配方程式藉以阻止有關人士作進一步行動。

所有的學校及家長們都要爲子女們,就算情況沒有 改變也不能例外,必須年年重新申請資助撥款。

沒有在意料之內的是每年被判斷爲弱能兒童的數目是不斷擴大,什至同類的弱能亦增加。

就像一些自閉症兒童的例子,每學期只能獲得六百 零五元緩助或只得助教教師每天十二分鐘的照顧時 間。

通常每一個學校的主流班都包括有數名弱能兒童, 他們各有不同的需要;對教師來說,既沒有額外的 援助,又期望他們去花額外精神應付這些非常難 題,完全是不合理的。

令校長們最憤怒的是真正需要援助的家庭卻失去機會。相反,那些明白系統的運作和不屈不撓地爭取的家長就獲得資助。對弱能兒童,尤其是他們的家長也是弱能和有困難的,實在是雙重打擊。

公立校長們證明大概有兩千五百名兒童缺乏援助, 或他們得到的援助微少到以"嚴重的不合適"來形容。

在選舉時這些群體的選票雖不足影響大局。工黨因 照顧他們,大概也多不了什么額外的支持;但當在 法院的審訊和諮詢進行時,選民會對目前政府爲下 一代的照顧能力 - 更加失去信心。
