


New Ladies Bible Study will begin on **Thursday, March 22nd**. This new study,

SUNDAY SCHOOL: WHO NEEDS IT?

Since many church members never attend Sunday school, the "who needs it" question deserves attention. Just to get this question in focus, let's assume the church has no Sunday school. What difference would it make?

- 1. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be no systematic approach to teaching persons of all ages the Word of God. (Acts 5:42)
- 2. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be no concerted effort to reach persons who are outside the influence of the church.
- 3. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be less continuing opportunity for a significant number of our members to use their talents for God.
- 4. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be no formal Christian influence on members and prospects.
- 5. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be no serious attempt to involve large numbers of people in Christian worship.
- 6. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be no effective avenue for providing a continuous witness to lost people.
- 7. If we didn't have a Sunday school, there would be no consistent way to instruct and enlist our members in the stewardship principle of life.
