Benefits	Project outcomes will be directed at their respective communities and West Rainy River as a whole. Identifying youth leaders in the region for future community programs.

Approval Process	<p>Grant Review Committee will review the applications and ensure the finalists are picked in a manner to support all two townships fairly.</p> <p>Decisions will be informed to the grant applicants before the project start date.</p> <p>Winners will be awarded a portion of the grant at the beginning and the remainder will be awarded upon the completion of the project and submission of a final project summary.</p>
Duration	<p>Project periods: Projects should start between June 01st and be completed before September 30th 2023 (can be a single day project or run throughout the period).</p>

Grant Guides for Review Team

- Ensure the fairness of distribution of Grant money by guaranteeing each of the 2 partnering townships are served with a main grant recipient (\$800 each) and two junior grants (\$300 each)
 - In the case of no applications from a township, committee is requested to find the next best application from the other township, where the impact of the project will benefit the region
- Junior grant recipient to be picked based on
 - Creativity and innovativeness
 - Project that has the most impact
- One open grant worth of \$300, to be given at the discretion of the review committee, to a resident child of either Rainy River or Dawson who are under the age of 18, under the “Community Impact” category
- Ensure each project meet the highlighted guidelines
