Ohio. Mental Health and Emergency Preparedness experts from community

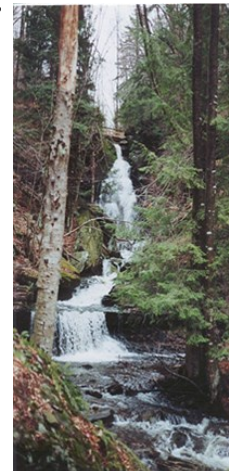
healthcare organizations team together to prepare for and mitigate the consequences of emergency events.
