2020 YSA Game Day Guidelines Prior to 9/21/20

- Any player, parent, or spectator of any kind should not attend a match if they have been informed to quarantine, been in contact with someone, or have ran a fever or experienced any symptoms of COVID 19 within the last 48 hours.
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times with 6 feet of space between families. If social distancing cannot be maintained, mask are required for all spectators.
- Spectators not following social distancing guidelines and not conforming to mask requirements may be removed from the sidelines.
- Mask are required for any player not actively participating on the field if they are not able to maintain proper social distancing.
- Only 2 teams should be on any at field at any given time (teams playing or warming up for their match).
- If the field is occupied by 2 teams, players waiting for their match should stay in their vehicle until match ends and current players, coaches, and spectators exit the field area.
- Teams will share a sideline with their spectators directly across the field from the side their team is sitting on. Spectators can use their entire side of the field, including behind the goals if needed to allow for social distancing. If any spectator is deemed to be coaching and or harassing any player, coach, or referee, they will be removed from the area immediately.
- No parent or spectators will be allowed to sit on the teams sideline.
- Team benches and common sitting areas are not allowed. It is encouraged for each player to bring their own chair to the match and set it up 6 feet from any other player. Coaches may choose to have their players 3 to 4 players wide by 3 to 4 players deep. The designated player area will be 5 yards off the center stripe on each side of the sideline.
- Each coach will need to come by the concession stand prior to their first match on Saturday to pick up a team bottle of sanitizer to be used during and after matches.
- Teams cannot shake hands before, during, or after a match. They are encouraged to line up and walk by each other at a distance of 6 feet with their traditional "good game" recognition.
- There are to be no team water coolers.
- Goalies are allowed to wear pennies, but a clean one must be issued to each goalie. Gloves cannot be shared as well.
- Referees will start each match with a sanitized soccer ball and clean it again at half time.
- There is to be no play on idle fields by anyone. This includes before, after, and during halftime of all matches.
- Fields are for game use only and will have goals sanitized periodically throughout the day.
- A maximum of 3 people is allowed in a restroom at any given time. Mask are also required while in the restroom.
- There will be hand sanitizer available at each mobile concession stand.
- Golf cart assistance is available at the red trailer.
