Description: The EMT program is designed to educate students to the US DOT requirements to become licensed as an Emergency Medical Technician in the State of Maine, and certified by the National Registry of EMT's. Labs include: Airway Management, Patient Assessment, Trauma Care and Medical Emergencies. Students who complete the course with a 75% average are eligible to participate in the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) psychomotor exam and sit for the NREMT and cognitive exam.

Classes will run every Tuesday and Thursday, 5 PM to 9PM (Week of 4th of July off) and **Saturdays, June 8th, June 22nd, July 13th, (Class Time 8:00 am to 5:00 pm); July 20th, (Class Time 8:00 am to 12:00 pm) July 27th, (Class Time 8:00 am to 5:00 pm; August 3rd, August 10th, (Class Time 8:00 am to 12:00 pm) and August 17th, (Class Time 8:00 am to 12:00 pm).**
