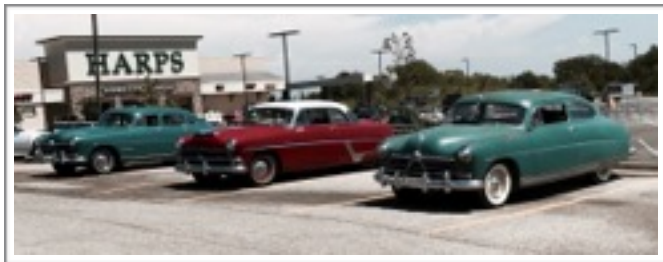

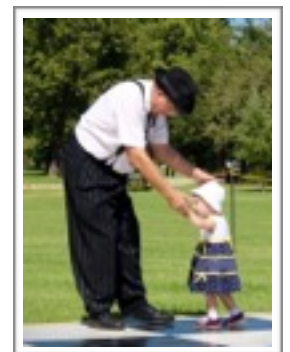
regional meet in 2020. All in all it was a nice day for a drive in a Hudson, good food and good friends. It can't get much better than that.
