YOUTH NEWS

As the weather is beginning to get warmer, our youth are beginning to plan for our upcoming mission trip and

service opportunities. During the Holy Week celebrations, the youth will participate in the Maundy Thursday service by portraying the Living Last Supper, a drama that highlights the last meal that Jesus shared with his disciples before he was arrested, put on trial, and crucified the next day. They will also be in service to our children for our Easter Celebration on Saturday, March 31, helping to make a fun and memorable experience learning about the resurrection of Jesus and finding eggs that represent new life.

On April 14, the youth will have a booth at the Cherry Blossom Festival again this year. Our focus this year will be evangelism. Jesus has instructed us to be fishers of men and go make disciples. The youth have taken that command seriously and look forward to the opportunity to share their faith.

Our Pennsylvania Mission Trip planning is under way. The youth will be doing a variety of service activities. On Sunday, Father's Day, they will help to lead the worship at a UMC congregation in the morning by singing and doing a puppet skit. That afternoon, they will host a community outreach event for that same congregation with hotdogs, games, and a play to spark local interest and involvement. The youth will visit a retirement facility with their puppets, volunteer in a thrift store, and do clean-up and repair at a local Christian camp. They will also work in the community doing some needed repairs for the church and the elderly. As the week progresses, they will have the opportunity to work on an Amish farm and experience a simpler vet very productive way of life.

This spring is blossoming into a time filled with many opportunities for our youth. If your youth is not involved, maybe now is a time to make a fresh start and join us for faith-filled fun.
