One of the first events at the National Corvette Museum is the Michelin NCM Bash April 26 to April 28. We will be attending this event and I hope others will join us in Bowling Green Kentucky.

Registration is now open for the 2018 Michelin Bash. The Bash traditionally marks the rollout of the next model year Corvette and the NCM is the place where you can see them up close and in detail, and get all the latest information on the all new ZR1 Corvette.

There are numerous seminars and sessions to choose from along with guided road tours, two celebrity choice car shows and the Garage Party led by women of the GM Corvette Team and geared toward ladies only. The Corvette Racing team with Team Manager Doug Fehan are back this year, as well as a presentation on the restored 1962 Sinkhole Corvette and an LT4 Engine building demonstration by Bowling Green Assembly Plant personnel.

On-line registration closes at 8:00am central time on Tuesday, April 18 and activities are open to Event Registrants only. Roar Before the 24: Corvette Racing left Daytona International Speedway early in January content with the results of its testing program following the annual *Roar Before the*



24 and ahead of the opening race of the 2018 IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship season.

The two Corvette C7.Rs logged more than 1,400 miles between them during the three days and eight sessions of track time. The packed schedule included a 15-minute qualifying session to determine assignments for the pit

boxes and garages for the team's return on January 25-28 for the Rolex 24 at Daytona.

The 56th Rolex 24 At Daytona was the start of the 2018 IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship season and was the weekend where it all began in January 1999 for Corvette Racing!

Corvette Racing has enjoyed numerous successes in this program and, as a team, they have set the global



standard in professionalism and performance. Drivers such as the current team as well as Ron Fellows and Johnny O'Connell have earned superstar status through their longstanding association with Corvette Racing. Did you know (*or remember*) that Dale Earnhardt and Dale Earnhardt Jr. raced for the team in the 2001 Rolex 24?

Program Manager Doug Fehan gave his presentation to a packed crowd in the Corvette Corral and was obviously in a good mood the morning after the No. 3 Corvette C7.R captured Pole Position in the GTLM class for Saturday's start of the 24. Drafting wasn't in the plans but Magnussen was able to get a tow from teammate Oliver Gavin in the No. 4 C7.R to vault him to the top of GTLM qualifying.



Corvette Racing is the defending series champions and the team turned in a mistake-free run in this 24-hour endurance race with the Corvette C7.Rs achieving third- and fourth-place class finishes (No. 3 and No. 4 respectively). This was the second Rolex 24 podium in two years for Magnussen, Antonio Garcia and Mike Rockenfeller after they finished second two years ago, and giving Garcia

and Magnussen positive momentum as they seek to defend their GTLM Driver Championship from last year.

In the No. 4 Corvette C7.R, Oliver Gavin, Tommy Milner and Marcel Fässler placed fourth and had a similarly clean run throughout Saturday and Sunday. Neither Corvette went off-track nor made any mistakes; all pit stops went smoothly...a hallmark of this program.



The next event for Corvette Racing is the *Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring Fueled by Fresh from Florida* on March 15-17 at Sebring International Raceway.
