Disciples of Christ has submitted a list of potential preachers and the committee has researched each candidate to see if they would be a good fit for our church. It is a daunting task to find candidates that will fit, not only our church, and the wonderful family feel we have, but also a somewhat part time position instead of full time since our operating budget will not allow very large salaries. This is limiting our options, but the committee has three prospects, all of which will preach during the month of February. The committee will welcome feedback of each minister from the congregation so they can get a feel as to how that candidate fits within our church family.

The candidates are Norman Jean Alexander and Dave Hargrove. Ray Owens has also approached the church stating he is interested in the position as well.

Norman Jean Alexander currently lives in Amarillo, Texas and attended Brite Divinity at Texas Christian University along with East Texas State University.

Dave Hargrove currently lives in Arlington, Texas and attended Texas Christian University and the Houston Graduate School of Theology.

And Ray Owens, you all know, as he has been guest preaching for our church for the past 4 weeks. Ray will continue to preach at our church in February on the Sundays the other two candidates are not preaching.

JANUARY BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS

- Mike Rippy presented the December report and End of Year financial report. Our State Farm Insurance payment was paid twice. They are reimbursing us for \$1,908.36. Our bank sent the additional payment without our approval. \$9,555.14 in offerings came in during December and expenses were \$7,859.99. Our year to date total for 2019 was \$84,007.49 in income and \$84,447.69 in expenses. Our offerings in 2018 were \$79,119,36 and offerings in 2019 were \$83,184.32. Our yearly attendance was 2,126 people that attended church. Over the last four years our attendance has increased each year, coming from 1,836 people in 2016 to 2,126 people in 2019. The church program for children and Preacher Massey drew families and new members during the past few years.
- Andy Dimock presented the New Minister Committee report. Karen Chilton, Marilyn Chamberlin, Danielle
 Chamberlin and Andy Dimock are on our New Minister Committee. The committee has filled out the parishioner
 report about our church and the Disciples of Christ will match us with a list of possible ministers. The committee
 will pick a few prospects to have them come and preach at our church. Ray Owens will be guest preaching for the
 month of January. Potential preachers will come in the month of February. Hopefully, we have a new preacher
 hired in March 2020.
- Brittany Yokovich contacted the church to include an article in the upcoming Weston Newsletter about our Live Nativity event. Our event will be featured in their first newsletter coming out the first week of February.
- Bank Corp South bought Texas Star Bank. It is in a transition period. We will be staying with Bank Corp South as of now and we will see how things go through the year. We may look in to moving our CDs from the Anna branch to the Celina branch when they come up for renewal.
- Our Valentine's luncheon will be on Sunday, February 9, 2020. Kimberly Tisserand will set up tables and chairs and Scooter Cave will decorate tables.
- Karen Chilton brought up the idea of a service project for the church. It is an organization called Feed My Starving Children. The board loved this idea. Karen Chilton will work on getting a date secured for us to volunteer.
